


We want to give you an update about where we are and what we are doing. After about 21 hours of layover and flight time, we finally arrived in Saipan on the 26th of January. It was a long flight. However, we thank the Lord for His hand upon us. We reached safely. We thought we might have issues with the customs, but again, God's hand was in the entire process. We sat down for about 30 minutes; the agent checked our documents and let us in. Since we were back, I have been teaching, and my son, Enoch, is back in school.

However, part of our hearts is still in India. We pray, think, and communicate regularly with our ministry partners in India. I regularly speak with students enrolled at the Bible College. It is hard to leave all of them and come, but we believe God has a plan.

We planted a small vegetable farm (very small) for Bible College use. It is growing, and it looks beautiful (yes, I love some farming). Some tomato, some Eggplant, some greens, and finally some Green Hot Chillies (Of course, we love that spice). The ten coconut trees we planted so students can get some tasty coconut water in a year or so are all done for the sake of Bible College students, so that we will have some fresh food.

Our intention and desire are to train *100* students every *4* years; send them out to make disciples, despite the harsh, changing religious conditions in India. Though there is persecution and constant growth of anti-Christian sentiment, my concern is losing a soul. Every soul matters to God. As Ezekiel 33:11 tells us, God desires that no one, not even a wicked person, should perish, but that they repent of their sins and be restored to God. So, we tried to plant the Gospel in the hearts of many people, and we will continue to proclaim the Gospel now and in the future, as long as the Lord keeps us here. This is my primary goal. However, to reach a country of such size, roughly 1.4 billion and growing, we need more *faithful servants* of the Lord, trained and equipped with the *Word of God*, which has the *transforming power*. Please. Pray with us.



We also need God's wisdom in matters where we must make decisions. Please join us in praying for God's guidance and wisdom.

We have an invitation to go to Sweden to preach to a small Indian congregation that needs some help and encouragement in June. Please pray that we would be able to visit to encourage the Church.
