Dear Pastor and Church Family,

We hope this prayer letter finds you doing well. We praise the Lord for His goodness and blessings in the ministry. We are grateful for your prayers and support that provide for many needs in our lives.

Summer has finally arrived here in Canada. Our snow has melted and everything is growing and turning green. Our days are filled with much outside work accompanied with balancing ministry activities. It is a blessing to see spiritual growth in new Christians and the Lord working in the lives of those who have not yet received Christ. I often compare the ministry to our two big gardens. Tilling the ground, taking out rocks, planting seeds, watering and weeding are all hard work, but it pays off in the end. We have God's promise in Gal. 6:9 *"...for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not."* Praise the Lord for His faithfulness!

Praise the Lord for the doors that He opens to share the Gospel. I am still able to meet with a young man at our church building once a week for lunch and talk about life in general.
