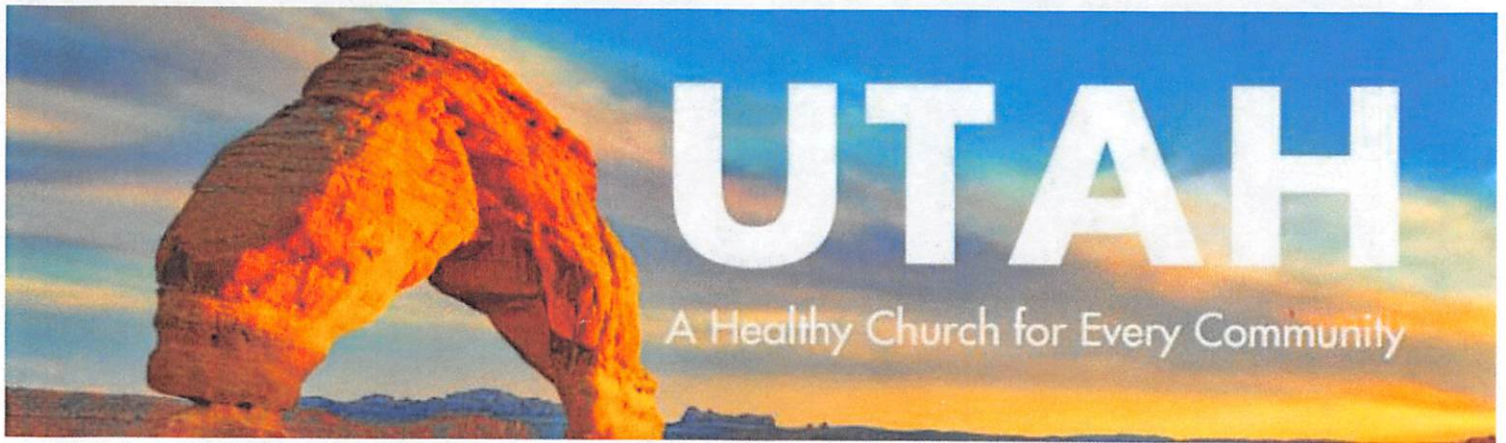

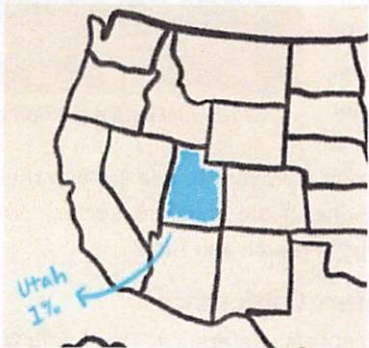


### Conference for Former Mormons



Last month we hosted a conference for former Mormons that have recently left the Mormon faith. We had around 45 people in attendance. Every attendee was given an opportunity to join a small discipleship group with a former Mormon that is now a Christian. We now have multiple small groups that have started. ### Utah Statistics



In April, a well-known missions organization released a graphic highlighting the need for church planting in Utah, estimating the state at around 1% Christian. While I believe the number is likely closer to 2–2.5%, the reality remains the same: the need is significant. And yet, during that need, I am more convinced than ever that God is at work drawing people to Himself.

This past Sunday, I was standing near the exit doors after our service when a man introduced himself and shared that he had recently left Mormonism and was beginning to investigate the biblical Jesus. Within moments, another man approached and shared the exact same story. Then, while I was still speaking with them, a woman from Japan joined the conversation and explained that she came from a Shinto background but had recently begun exploring who Jesus is and believes He may be the answer she has been searching for. I cannot recall another moment when

three individuals, all from different backgrounds, approached me at the same time expressing a desire to know Christ. It was a sweet reminder that God is drawing people to Himself, and I had the privilege of pointing them to Him.

### Easter

Our Easter celebration was incredible. Each year, we rent a large venue and intentionally reach out to our community, inviting people to join us. We invest heavily in Easter week as a strategic outreach opportunity. Historically, Easter has not been widely observed in Mormon culture, which makes it a unique opportunity for gospel engagement here in Utah.

This year, hundreds joined us for our Easter service. We concluded the service by celebrating baptisms, and the Lord allowed us to witness something truly special. Twenty-five individuals publicly professed their faith in Christ through believer's baptism. A record for us. Many of them are first-generation believers.

Baptisms are some of the sweetest moments we experience as the people of God. They are visible reminders of new life, redemption, and the transforming power of the gospel. I've included a few photos from that day. While these individuals may not know your name, you are part of their story. Through your prayers, support, and partnership, you are part of what God is doing here in Utah.

I have the privilege of knowing many of their stories personally. I've seen the beauty of God's work in their lives, and I truly believe that one day in eternity, you will hear their stories of redemption as well
