A neighboring professional violinist heard the group and offered two free master classes. His daughters also attended the VBS. They had the privilege of helping to worship the Lord through music in four different church fellowships, and all

this during the kids' school break. One was a very large church, and some were quite small, but all were deeply touched by the sacrifice the group made to make the two-day journey to minister to them.
