The Mexico Mission

Happy Spring,

January through March has been a lot of traveling, planning, and working in the community of Ramos Arizpe and Saltillo. We flew back to Mexico after spending Christmas and new years in Texas with our families. During our reentry, one of the workers gave Cade a 6 month VISA, and another worker only gave Judith a 1 month

VISA. This caused us to drive back to Texas at the end of January. During our time in Texas, we were able to have a board meeting, a missions meeting with the group from Aurora, fix some things on our vehicle, and meet with our tax agent . Our original plan was to only be in Texas for a week, but Cade became really sick on Feb. 5, with a high fever, and other symptoms, so we took a trip to urgent care, and drove back to Mexico on the 10th.

February consisted a lot of planning for VBS, and teaching the people of El Vástago how to facilitate a VBS, since this was their first one to host. A group of 12 came from Aurora Baptist church to visit from March 14-20. The group helped with VBS, did a work day at the church, passed out groceries and school supplies, encouraged our people, encouraged us, and had a fun day in town. They were able to complete all of the projects that needed to be done at the church. Those projects included installing 2 fans and new lights in the new kids area, wrapping and installing 2 dividing walls in the new kids area, painting the sanctuary and kitchen, fixing our sound board and audio, finishing out the dividing wall and installing a door in the kids area downstairs, and then cleaning and organizing the kitchen. Thank you to our home church for all of your support in every way imaginable!

VBS was incredible. We had 29 workers (Aurora and El Vástago), 58 kids, and 33 salvations (21 kids, 12 adults)! The Lord definitely blessed all of the hard work that was put into it. While VBS was going on, many parents were standing around watching, and hearing the gospel, while also hearing it from Cade, Heriberto, and Heriberto's mom who were walking around witnessing to them.

Thank you to everyone who prayed for the VBS, your prayers were felt, and answered.

After we finished our VBS, and saw the fruit, we have decided to do more ministry in the community of Analco (where we had the VBS). Heriberto also has a vision to purchase a van so that we can start picking people up and bringing them to the church, since most families don't own a vehicle and have to pay for transportation. So far we have raised \$2,000 towards this project. If you as a church would like to donate, and you give through the CMC please put in the notes/comment section that it is for the church van. If you are an individual who would like to give you can also give through the CMC, and do the same thing. If you attend Aurora Baptist, or give through Aurora, please write on your tithe envelope or online "Mexico Mission Church Van". We are excited to see how the Lord uses this.

There are also more ministry opportunities in the works for the Analco area. Keep praying for Mexico, El Vástago, and The Mexico Mission.

January 29: Drove to Texas (Judith was only given a 1 month VISA)

February 1: Meeting with mission group from Aurora
February 3: Meeting with our mission board
February 10: Drove back to Mexico
February 17: VBS planning meeting with Heriberto and Mariana
February 18: VBS meeting with some of the kid ministry leaders
February 22: Cade preached on the four pillars of the early church. In the afternoon we visited a local church in Saltillo to pass out materials, and teach their children's ministry workers how to effectively run a kids ministry.
February 28: Ladies Bible Study

March 4: VBS Meeting
March 8: Helping a local church with materials and training for their kids ministry
March 11: VBS meeting
March 12: Final VBS meeting, where we showed the workers how we were going to set up for VBS in the park. We also split into groups to pass out invitations in the neighborhood.
March 14-20: Group from Aurora Baptist came to help with VBS, and help us with some projects at El Vástago.
March 14: Activity with the kids at Big Heart Orphanage
March 16-18: El Vástago's 1st VBS (33 Salvations!)
March 17: Work day at the church. Aurora completed all of the tasks on the to-do list
March 22: Judith in the nursery at church
March 26: Leader Meeting
