Tuesday Girls Hangout



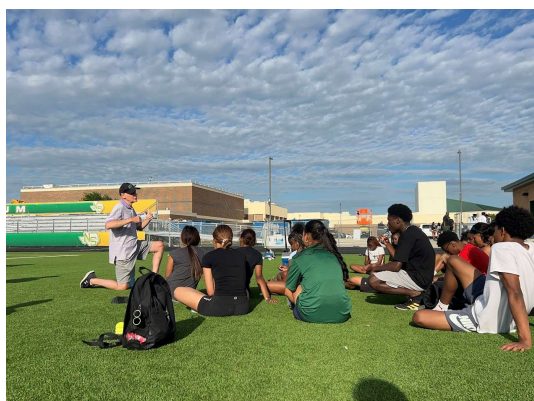
