Hello Friends and Family,

Greetings from Lima! We hope this letter finds you well and faithfully serving our great God. First, we want to say thank you for keeping us in your prayers and for your support. We couldn't be here if it weren't for you!

During the last three months we had some exciting experiences as a family and with the church. In April our church was able to join efforts with two other churches to organize a camp for Easter week. It was great to get out of the city for a few days to meditate on the redemptive work of Christ on our behalf. Another highlight was when we took the youth to an evangelistic outreach in an orphanage. It was great to see them work for the Lord. They planned games, songs, skits, preaching, and gifts of clothing.

In May, several of the restrictions that made us have to establish two services on Sundays were lifted, and now we can all meet in one service. We love our congregation! We thank God for everyone in our church, and we are excited to have added seven new members. We started using the third floor to broadcast the service live so that everyone can fit, and every Sunday we have approximately twenty-five people that go up there to watch the service. Please keep praying for God's will to be done with our church. We are still keeping our eyes open for a bigger place, but every lead has been a closed door. In the meantime, we still hold our AWANA club at the public park (even now in winter), the youth still meet in different homes each Saturday, and we accommodate our activities around the availability of the building we currently use. This weighs on us, but God knows what is best. Please pray for wisdom in this regard and for church growth in the knowledge of God, faithfulness, and unity.

Finally, I would like to share a highlight of this quarter. Giorgio was preaching at the annual missions' conference of AMEBIP, a Peruvian missions agency, where he ran into five missionary families that our church supports in different areas of Peru. They all came to visit our church on
