Greetings from Lima! Once again, we rejoice in the faithfulness of our Lord and are grateful for the opportunity to share what He has been doing in and through the ministry this past season. Truly, it is only by His grace that we continue to serve, and we give Him all the glory.

This trimester has been full of summer ministry opportunities both near and far with many camps and conferences. One of the most special experiences was a mission trip to Iquitos, where 52 members of our church, along with visitors, participated. We focused especially on children's ministry as a way to reach families, sharing the gospel through activities, lessons, and personal interactions. It was a joy to see entire families engaged and to witness how the Lord used these efforts to open doors for evangelism.

We also traveled twice to Urubamba. On one occasion, Giorgio had the opportunity to teach a class for young adults, and on another trip, he taught a seminary module. In addition, both of us traveled to Chile to serve at a youth camp, where we were encouraged to see young people desiring to grow in their walk with the Lord. Finally, we were invited to Flint, Michigan, where we had the privilege of sharing the wonderful things God has been doing here in Peru. It was a blessing to reconnect with dear brothers and sisters and testify of His work.

Without a doubt, one of the greatest highlights of this season was the celebration of our church's first anniversary. Yet even beyond that, we were able to celebrate the opening of our church building on February 15. We truly wish we could fully express how remarkable this is. In this area, marked by its social conditions and a culture that is often indifferent or traditionally religious, it is almost unheard of for such a young church to have its own building.
