Dear praying friends and family,

Greetings from Peru! As we look back over these past months, we are reminded once again of God's faithfulness. Thank you for your prayers, encouragement, and faithful partnership with our family and the ministry He has entrusted to us.

God's Faithful Provision

Construction and adaptation of our church building have continued to move forward. We inaugurated the building on February 15 without a roof, trusting the Lord to provide what was still needed. Shortly afterward, God placed on our hearts the opportunity to help purchase land for a church plant in the Amazon jungle that we have been partnering with. As we followed His direction in that, the Lord then provided exactly the amount needed for the roof of our own church building.

We have seen the Lord provide through the generosity, skills, and sacrificial service of many people. Each step has been a reminder that this is His work, and we look forward to seeing how He will continue to use this building to serve His church and advance the Gospel.

The local church family also continues to grow by God's grace. New families have joined us, while others are taking important steps of faith through baptism, discipleship, and growing involvement in the life of the church. It is encouraging to see the Lord building His church and giving us opportunities to walk alongside people as they grow in Christ.

A Growing Vision for Missions

One of the greatest highlights of this season was a missions trip that Giorgio, along with two other men from our church, had the privilege of taking. Over 19 days, they traveled primarily to Spain, Egypt, Uganda, and Germany to visit missionaries supported by our church.

The purpose of the trip was not simply to observe their ministries, but to encourage these faithful servants, pray with them, listen to their joys and burdens, and better understand the unique contexts in which they proclaim Christ. Meeting missionaries where they serve gave our church a deeper appreciation for both the opportunities and the challenges of cross-cultural ministry.

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In Egypt, Giorgio had the opportunity to speak with local Christians and pastors and preach in several church meetings. In Uganda, he was able to teach a week-long module to local pastors. These experiences reminded us of the importance of strengthening the local church through faithful biblical teaching and training. The trip also expanded our church's vision for world missions. We were introduced to three additional missionaries whose faithful labor for Christ deeply impressed us. After learning more about their ministries, our church joyfully began supporting them.

During these months, Giorgio also made several trips to northern Peru to teach and train pastors. These opportunities to open God's Word and encourage men in ministry have reinforced the great need for sound biblical training throughout the country. Please pray that these pastors will continue to shepherd their churches with faithfulness and endurance.

Taking the Gospel to Pucallpa

July brought another special opportunity for our church to serve together in missions. We traveled to Pucallpa, in the Peruvian jungle, with a team of 60 participants. During the trip, we held two Vacation Bible Schools and had many opportunities to evangelize and share the Gospel. Our team served alongside local believers, encouraged churches, and spent time reaching people in the surrounding communities. There were countless conversations, Gospel presentations, and opportunities to point people to Christ.

Perhaps one of the greatest encouragements of the trip was seeing the church family participate together. Young and old served, worked, prayed, shared the Gospel, and cared for people. We pray that the Lord will use what was planted during these days and that the Gospel conversations will bear fruit long after our team has returned home.

As we continue forward, we are increasingly aware that the opportunities for ministry are greater than what we can accomplish in our own strength. We need the Lord's wisdom, provision, and power.

Thank you for standing with us through your prayers, encouragement, and financial support. Your partnership enables us to continue serving here in Peru and to participate in what God is doing both locally and around the world. We are deeply grateful that you labor with us through prayer.
