Sermon Series: "One Another"

Week 1 Title: "Encourage One Another"

Reference: Hebrews 10:19-25

Howdy Church Family,

I hope your week is going great! Last week we talked about Loving One Another. I hope that you've had chances to pause "normality" to give attention to someone else. Remember, we have a definition for the idea of love: Jesus' life. Our question for to be working with was, "What would love require of me here?"

As we look toward this Sunday, I want to help you begin leaning into the theme we'll be exploring: Encouragement. Not just the kind that helps someone smile, but also the kind rooted in Jesus—the kind that restores courage, builds faith, and reminds us we're not walking by ourselves.

Hebrews 10:19–25 gives us a powerful picture of what encouragement looks like in the family of God. It begins with confidence in Jesus, moves into attention toward one another, and grows strong when we stay connected. This week, I'd love for you to begin asking a simple question: Who around me might need courage right now?

Maybe it's someone tired. Someone quiet. Someone who's been quietly but consistently serving. Someone who's been drifting. Someone who needs to be reminded that because of Jesus, the door to God's presence is still wide open.

As you get ready for Sunday, take a moment to pray: "Lord, help me see the people You've placed around me. Help me speak life where life is needed."
