## June 14, 2026: “When Trust Becomes Transformation”

Howdy Church Family,

This Sunday, we step into Message 5 of our Pentecost series, and it may be the most personal one yet. We’ve watched how the Spirit formed the early church into a devoted, awe and wonder-filled, generous, life-sharing, world-blessing community. But this week we’re asking a deeper question:

What initiates the internal life change in these people?

Acts 2 shows us a powerful pattern:

- Truth
- Cut to the heart
- Trust
- Change

Peter proclaimed the truth of Jesus. The people were cut to the heart. They trusted Him. And the Spirit transformed them into a new creation.

We’ll talk about how trust—real trust—opens the door to transformation. How trusting Jesus is not just about changing what we do, but about becoming a new kind of person. And I’ll share a simple story from outside my office window that has been teaching me about trust in a pretty cool way.

I encourage you to read Acts 2:37–47 and ask Jesus: “Where are You inviting me to trust You more?”
