Title Week 4: “Why He Came”

Mark 9-16

Hello Church Family!

Over the last three weeks, we’ve been walking through the Gospel of Mark — watching Jesus step into real life with real people. We’ve seen who He is, what He does, and what He reveals about God, His Will, and about us. And now we come to the final movement of Mark’s Gospel, where everything slows down, and the whole story comes into focus.

Mark opened with a headline: **“The beginning of the good news about Jesus...” (Mark 1:1)** And now, in Mark 9:1, Jesus says: **“You’re about to see the Kingdom come with power.”**

From that moment on, Mark shifted gears to write in weeks... days... & hours. He wants us to feel the weight of why Jesus came — and what it means for our everyday lives.

This Sunday matters because the cross and resurrection aren’t just events in history. They’re the center of our hope, our identity, and our daily life-walk with Jesus.

- **Mark 13:10** — Gospel to all nations.
- **Mark 15:39** — Son of God.
- **Mark 16:6** — He has risen.

Let's see Jesus clearly — and surrender everything we have to Him.
