Three Sermons - Hidden Treasure Pt 2

Howdy Church Family,

As we head toward Sunday, I wanted to pause and help us remember where we've been—and where we're going.

Last week we read Jesus' words together about treasure and the heart. We looked at the ways the world discipled us: how the ideas of having more can slowly change how and why we worry, how we make decisions, and even our feelings of worth. Some of you even shared afterward how you sometimes chase things that are not healthy long term (things that seemed like small treasure in the moment).

So here's the simple question to carry into the next few days:

What did you notice in your heart this week?

Did something feel heavier than it should? Did a possession, a plan, or a pressure/worry start revealing itself as a "lesser treasure"? Did you sense God inviting you to loosen your grip, or maybe to trust Him in a place where you've been relying on yourself?

This Sunday we're stepping deeper into that conversation. Jesus is going to show us how lesser treasures often look like wisdom, how they promise more than they can provide, and how real freedom comes from being rich toward God. It's a passage that meets us right where we live—our budgets, our worries, our comparisons, our hopes for the future.

Take a moment before Sunday to think:

- What have you been asking your possessions or plans to do for your soul, when they weren't meant for that purpose?
- Where has "wanting" quietly turned into "needing"?
- Where might Jesus be inviting you into a freer, more peaceful life?

We'll be in Luke 12.

Who might you ask to come with you? Ask...you never know!
