You also acknowledge to the elders of this congregation that you are in covenant with God, being active in a congregation which is covenantally bound to the Triune God through Word and sacrament.

CALL TO CONFESSION - *Psalm 130*

Out of the depths I have cried to You, O Lord; Lord, hear my voice! Let Your ears be attentive To the voice of my supplications.

If You, Lord, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You, That You may be feared.

I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, And in His word I do hope.

My soul waits for the Lord more than those who watch for the morning— Yes, more than those who watch for the morning.

O Israel, hope in the Lord; For with the Lord there is mercy,

And with Him is abundant redemption. And He shall redeem Israel From all his iniquities.

{*Pause for private confession.*}

{*Stand*}

... your sins are forgiven in Christ.

CONFESSION OF FAITH

Christian, in whom do you believe?

I believe in God the Father Almighty; Maker of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the Holy Ghost and born of the virgin, Mary.
