## THE TALE OF THREE MOMS

### THE STORY OF SACRIFICE

**1 Samuel 1:9-17 NLT** Once after a sacrificial meal at Shiloh, Hannah got up and went to pray. Eli the priest was sitting at his customary place beside the entrance of the Tabernacle. (10) Hannah was in deep anguish, crying bitterly as she prayed to the LORD. (11) And she made this vow: “O LORD of Heaven’s Armies, if you will look upon my sorrow and answer my prayer and give me a son, then I will give him back to you. He will be yours for his entire lifetime, and as a sign that he has been dedicated to the LORD, his hair will never be cut.” (12) As she was praying to the LORD, Eli watched her. (13) Seeing her lips moving but hearing no sound, he thought she had been drinking. (14) “Must you come here drunk?” he demanded. “Throw away your wine!” (15) “Oh no, sir!” she replied. “I haven’t been drinking wine or anything stronger. But I am very discouraged, and I was pouring out my heart to the LORD. (16) Don’t think I am a wicked woman! For I have been praying out of great anguish and sorrow.” (17) “In that case,” Eli said, “go in peace! May the God of Israel grant the request you have asked of him.”

### THE STORY OF OBEDIENCE

**Luke 1:26-38 NLT** In the sixth month of Elizabeth’s pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a village in Galilee, (27) to a virgin named Mary. She was engaged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of King David. (28) Gabriel appeared to her and said, “Greetings, favored woman! The Lord is with you!” (29) Confused and disturbed, Mary tried to think what the angel could mean. (30) “Don’t be afraid, Mary,” the angel told her, “for you have found favor with God! (31) You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you will name him Jesus. (32) He will be very great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his ancestor David. (33) And he will reign over Israel forever; his Kingdom will never end!” (34) Mary asked the angel, “But how can this happen? I am a virgin.”

(35) The angel replied, “The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the baby to be born will be holy, and he will be called the Son of God. (36) What’s more, your relative Elizabeth has become pregnant in her old age! People used to say she was barren, but she has conceived a son and is now in her sixth month. (37) For the word of God will never fail.” (38) Mary responded, “I am the Lord’s servant. May everything you have said about me come true.” And then the angel left her.

**2 Timothy 1:5-7 NLT** I remember your genuine faith, for you share the faith that first filled your grandmother Lois and your mother, Eunice. And I know that same faith continues strong in you. (7) For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline.
