EXCHANGING LIFE FOR LOVE

John 15:9-14 NLT

REMAIN IN LOVE

“I have loved you even as the Father has loved me. Remain in my love. (10) When you obey my commandments, you remain in my love, just as I obey my Father’s commandments and remain in his love.

Luke 6:46 NLT “So why do you keep calling me ‘Lord, Lord!’ when you don’t do what I say?”

BE FILLED WITH JOY

(11) I have told you these things so that you will be filled with my joy. Yes, your joy will overflow!

Romans 15:13 NLT I pray that God, the source of hope, will fill you completely with joy and peace because you trust in him. Then you will overflow with confident hope through the power of the Holy Spirit.

(8) But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.

1 John 5:3 NLT Loving God means keeping his commandments, and his commandments are not burdensome.

1 John 3:18 NLT Dear children, let’s not merely say that we love each other; let us show the truth by our actions.

COSTLY

1 Corinthians 13:4-7 NLT Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous or boastful or proud (5) or rude. It does not demand its own way. It is not irritable, and it keeps no record of being wronged. (6) It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. (7) Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance.

PRECIOUS

1 John 4:9-11 NLT God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. (10) This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins. (11) Dear friends, since God loved us that much, we surely ought to love each other.
