Palm Sunday

Luke 19:28-44 NLT

THE RIDE

After telling this story, Jesus went on toward Jerusalem, walking ahead of his disciples. (29) As he came to the towns of Bethphage and Bethany on the Mount of Olives, he sent two disciples ahead. (30) “Go into that village over there,” he told them. “As you enter it, you will see a young donkey tied there that no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here. (31) If anyone asks, ‘Why are you untying that colt?’ just say, ‘The Lord needs it.’” (32) So they went and found the colt, just as Jesus had said. (33) And sure enough, as they were untying it, the owners asked them, “Why are you untying that colt?” (34) And the disciples simply replied, “The Lord needs it.”

Luke 19:26-27 NLT “‘Yes,’ the king replied, ‘and to those who use well what they are given, even more will be given. But from those who do nothing, even what little they have will be taken away. (27) And as for these enemies of mine who didn’t want me to be their king— bring them in and execute them right here in front of me.’”

Mark 11:3 NLT If anyone asks, ‘What are you doing?’ just say, ‘The Lord needs it and will return it soon.’”

Matthew 21:2 NLT “Go into the village over there,” he said. “As soon as you enter it, you will see a donkey tied there, with its colt beside it. Untie them and bring them to me.

Zechariah 9:9 NLT Rejoice, O people of Zion! Shout in triumph, O people of Jerusalem! Look, your king is coming to you. He is righteous and victorious, yet he is humble, riding on a donkey—riding on a donkey’s colt.

THE CHEERS

(35) So they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their garments over it for him to ride on. (36) As he rode along, the crowds spread out their garments on the road ahead of him. (37) When he reached the place where the road started down the Mount of Olives, all of his followers began to shout and sing as they walked along, praising God for all the wonderful miracles they had seen.

(38) “Blessings on the King who comes in the name of the LORD! Peace in heaven, and glory in highest heaven!”

THE JEERS

(39) But some of the Pharisees among the crowd said, “Teacher, rebuke your followers for saying things like that!” (40) He replied, “If they kept quiet, the stones along the road would burst into cheers!”

Romans 8:20-22 NLT Against its will, all creation was subjected to God’s curse. But with eager hope, (21) the creation looks forward to the day when it will join God’s children in glorious freedom from death and decay. (22) For we know that all creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time.

THE TEARS

(41) But as he came closer to Jerusalem and saw the city ahead, he began to weep. (42) “How I wish today that you of all people would understand the way to peace. But now it is too late, and peace is hidden from your eyes. (43) Before long your enemies will build ramparts against your walls and encircle you and close in on you from every side. (44) They will crush you into the ground, and your children with you. Your enemies will not leave a single stone in place, because you did not recognize it when God visited you.”

John 14:27 NLT “I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don’t be troubled or afraid.
