There will be a Community Choir each night led by Cedric Burrell and Harrison Bridges from University of Mobile.

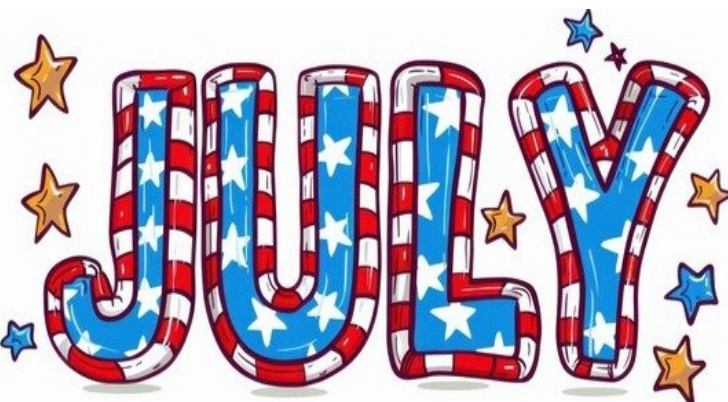
