I have been reading through Proverbs in my quiet times lately. Proverbs is such a good book to go to for just practical guidelines for daily living. As I near the end of the book of Proverbs, I am mindful of one of the more familiar verses in the book. Proverbs 29:18 says, "Where there is no vision, the people are unrestrained, but happy is he who keeps the law." (NAS) As I read this I am reminded that we need to keep a vision for TBC!
