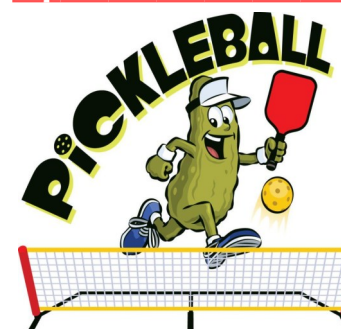

From the Pastor's Desk

A lady named Dorothy Canfield Fisher wrote a book in 1914 called "Mothers and Children" in which she was credited with coining the term "empty nest." She described the emotional transition, or even depression, that some parents go through when their last child leaves home. Well, I have told people recently that our home is about to be as empty as it is going to get. Obviously, our situation is different with Sarah Beth, but when Isaac graduates in a couple of weeks, things will be changing quickly for us. The different stages of life that we go through can teach us some lessons. I have thought about what those lessons are as both of our oldest two children are about to be out of the house. And the last thing I am thinking about is how I may have a little more time to focus on my own health and do some appropriate exercising for my age. After we have done the best we know how, there comes a time when we let them out into the world. Ps.127:3-5 says, "Sons are a heritage from the LORD, children a reward from him. Like arrows in the hands of a warrior are sons born in one's youth. Blessed is the man whose quiver is full of them." Arrows are made to shoot! Thank you Lord for a quiver that has been full that is about to look a little more empty! We just pray, and I believe other parents at TBC join with us in this prayer, that they will be in the center of Your will and carry out Your calling on their lives!
