CREATION CELEBRATION

Supplies:

1. "Creation Celebration" Activity Page (1 per child, printed on white cardstock)
2. "Creation Celebration – Stickers" Activity Pages (multiple sheets printed on OL2088)
3. Tissue paper confetti (various colors)
4. Crayons
5. Glue sticks

How-To:

1. Give each child an Activity Page.
2. Allow them to color their poster and add creation stickers.
3. Have them glue tissue paper confetti around the border of their page.

Say This:

Before the Activity:

We've been learning all month that there are so many AMAZING things that God has made! To help us remember and celebrate all the good things God made, let's make a fun poster!

During the Activity:

First, you can color your poster, and add these fun stickers to decorate it. Then, you can add some fun confetti around the edges. Our Bible verse is on the poster too!
