FLOOR CENTER

ROLL A FACE

During this activity, the children will roll cubes to create silly faces of people. Today we will learn that God made animals and people.

Supplies:

1. "Roll a Face" Activity Pages (cut apart)
2. Small boxes (3 cubes, 3" x 3")
3. Glue stick

How-To:

1. Glue the pictures from each set of Activity Pages to the sides of the cubes.
2. Have the children take turns rolling the cubes.
3. Help them stack the cubes to see the silly face they rolled.

Say This:

Before the Activity:

Look around at each of your friends. Some of us have blue eyes, some of us have brown eyes, and some of us have green eyes. Everyone, smile. *(Pause.)* Look at how amazing you all look when you smile! Can you make some some silly faces together? *(Pause.)* I love those silly faces. Today we are going to create some silly faces with these cubes.

During the Activity:

We have three cubes. They have pictures of eyes, noses, and mouths on them. We are going to roll them and stack them up to make a super silly face. *(Demonstrate.)* This is fun! Let's roll again! *(Continue rolling and stacking the cubes to make silly faces.)*

After the Activity:

We made so many silly faces of people with these cubes! Today we are going to learn something amazing about people. I can't wait to hear more about it.

BIBLE STORY: CREATION: DAY 6 – GENESIS 1:24-31

VERSE OF THE MONTH: “GOD SAW ALL THAT HE HAD MADE, AND IT WAS VERY GOOD.” GENESIS 1:31

CIRCLE TIME

What You Need:

1. Bible
2. Stickers

Say This:

Prompt the children to remember what they learned in The Playhouse. Celebrate when they remember!

- God made frogs, elephants, and all the (animals).
- When you see your favorite animal, you can say, (“Thank you, God”).
- The most special thing God made was (people, me, you).
- God makes good (things).

Practice the Verse:

Open the Bible to remind the children that our verse comes from the Bible.

Are you ready to practice our Bible verse? *(Let children respond.)* Okay, let’s all say it together.

“God (*point up*) saw all that he had made (*spread arms out*), and it was very good (*thumbs up*)”
Genesis 1:31. (*Open hands like a book.*)

Now, who wants to try saying it by yourself? *(Reward each child with a sticker for saying the verse.)*

Talk About It:

Today we learned that God made animals and people. Who are people you’re thankful for that God made? *(Help the children think of different people they are thankful for. Examples might be their parents, neighbors, their grandparents, or their friends at school.)*

Let’s pray and thank God for making good things!

Pray:

Dear God, thank you for making animals and people. Thank you for all of the different people in our lives, like *(talk about the people you discussed)*. We love you, God. Amen.

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TABLE TIME

CREATION CELEBRATION

Supplies:

1. “Creation Celebration” Activity Page (1 per child, printed on white cardstock)
2. Tissue paper confetti (various colors)
3. Crayons
4. Glue sticks

How-To:

1. Give each child an Activity Page.
2. Allow them to color their poster.
3. Have them glue tissue paper confetti around the border of their page.

Say This:

Before the Activity:

We’ve been learning all month that there are so many AMAZING things that God has made! To help us remember and celebrate all the good things God made, let’s make a fun poster!

During the Activity:

First, you can color your poster. Then, you can add some fun confetti around the edges. Our Bible verse is on the poster too! It says, “God saw all that he had made, and it was very good” Genesis 1:31. Can you say the Bible verse with me? (*Let children respond.*) “God saw all that he had made, and it was very good” Genesis 1:31.

After the Activity:

These posters look awesome! Great job decorating. Let’s take them home to help us remember that **[Big Idea] God makes good things!**
