EveryChild tips

- In place of running, encourage children to move, roll, walk, crawl, etc to get to the doctor's kit.

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Create a start line in an open area of your room with tape. Place the doctor's kit items inside the basket and set it on the opposite side of the room. Line children up behind the tape line, and lined up to participate one at a time.

During the Activity: Encourage children to run to the basket/bin, grab one item, and run back. The leader names the item and says what it's used for. Reset and repeat until all children have had a turn.

After the Activity: Introduce the Bible Story.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "Hello, hello friends! Come over here with me. We are going to play a game with all the toys that go in a doctor's kit. (*Hold up the empty doctor's kit.*) Let's line up behind the tape line right here, and we'll take turns running to the basket/bin and pulling one item, and then run back."










During the Activity: "Okay! [Child's name], run to the bucket/bin and pick one thing to bring back. (*Pause.*) Oh wow! Do you know that that is? (*Hold item up for everyone to see.*) It's a [name of item] and a doctor uses it to [name its use]! Great job! (*Place it in the doctor's kit.*) [Child's name], your turn! (*Continue with each child. Reset the items as needed if you have more children than items.*) Hooray! We did it! We learned about a lot of tools that doctors use to help people."

After the Activity: "Today in our true story from the Bible, we're going to hear how Jesus cared about everyone everywhere He went. In towns, villages, and countrysides! Let's go hear how Jesus helped the people in our story today."

Before the Activity: Print "Everyone" on cardstock and cut eight per Small Group. Tape a paperclip to the back of each picture of Jesus, leaving about an inch showing. Cover the table with butcher paper and tape to secure. Stick smiley face stickers all around the table. *Optional: Draw smiley faces around the table in place of stickers.*

During the Activity: Demonstrate how to place a crayon in the paperclip and move the picture of Jesus to each smiley face. Encourage children to take Jesus around the table to everyone. Repeat as time and interest allow.

After the Activity: Introduce the Bible Story.

Before the Activity: "Come to the table, friends. Look at all these smiley faces!"





During the Activity: "We're going to take Jesus around to all the happy faces like this. Put your crayon in this part (*point to the paperclip*) and drag it along the paper like this. (*Demonstrate.*) See how the crayon is leaving a path. Now it's your turn! Pick a crayon and move your Jesus picture to each and every one of the smiley faces on the table. (*Pause.*) Great job! Look at all the colorful marks on the paper. Jesus went everywhere and saw everyone!"

After the Activity: "Today in our Bible Story, we'll hear how Jesus traveled all over and everywhere He went, people came to see Him. Let's go hear how Jesus helped the people in our story."

5 min

Community Helper Dress-Up | Made to Imagine

What You Need

-  Dress-up clothes of community helpers (firefighters, doctors, etc.) 1
-  Dress-up hats 1
-  Preschool-safe standing mirror 1
-  Optional: "Community Helper Dress-Up" 1 Activity Page, cardstock, sentence strips, stapler, clear tape, and scissors in place of dress-up hats.

Memory Verse with Motions | Made to Move *Uses Minimal Supplies

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Place the dress-up clothes near the mirror. *Optional:* Print "Community Helper Dress-Up" on cardstock and cut one set per Small Group. Staple each hat cutout to a sentence strip, close the ends, and staple shut. Place a piece of tape over the staple closures.

During the Activity: Invite children to choose a costume with a hat to wear and encourage them to look at themselves in the mirror after they get dressed. Encourage children to role-play who they're dressed as. Continue with each child. Repeat as time and interest allow.

After the Activity: Introduce the Bible Story.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "Hello, hello friends! Come over here and look at all these dress-up clothes and hats. Who do you want to be today?"

During the Activity: "You could be a firefighter. (Hold up the firefighter hat.) Or a doctor. (Hold up the doctor hat.) Let's get dressed up like community helpers. (Pause.) [Child's name], look in the mirror and pretend to be a [community helper]. Great job! Come stand with me and let [child's name] look in the mirror and pretend to be a [community helper]. (Continue with each child.) Doctors help us when we're sick. Firefighters help when there's a fire. Community helpers are great at helping people!"

After the Activity: "Helpers care for people. Today in our Bible Story, we'll hear how people came from all over to bring their sick friends to see Jesus, because they knew He could help. Let's go hear how Jesus helped these people."

**EveryChild tips****EveryChild Pro-Tips:**

- Invite children to say it with you or repeat words after you.
- Set out the picture cutouts made from the "Memory Verse Hand Motions" PDF for children to hold up or point to as an alternative to saying or repeating the verse out loud.

Before the Activity: "Friends, come stand with me! Let's learn our brand-new Memory Verse. It tells us how BIG Jesus' love is, and it goes like this: 'How wide (*stretch arms out wide*) and long (*stretch arms forward*) and high (*reach arms up*) and deep (*crouch down low*) is the love of Christ. (*Hug yourself.*) Ephesians 3:18." (*Open hands like a book.*)

During the Activity: "Now, let's learn the motions! The first part says, 'How wide.' Everyone, stretch your arms out as wide as you can. (*Stretch arms out wide.*) Great! The next part says, 'and long.' Stretch your arms out in front of you. (*Stretch arms forward.*) The next part says, 'and high.' Put your arms up way up high over your head. (*Reach arms up.*) Next part says, 'and deep.' Squat and get really small. (*Crouch down low.*) Super! And the last part says, 'is the love of Christ.' Give yourself a great big hug.

(*Hug yourself.*) Ephesians 3:18. (*Open hands like a book.*) Let's do it again!" (*Repeat several times.*)

After the Activity: "Our verse teaches us that Jesus' love is big! Huge! In our true story from the Bible, Jesus helped people in every town and village. Jesus didn't miss anyone because **[Bottom Line]Jesus cares about everyone.** Who does Jesus care about?**[Bottom Line]-Jesus cares about everyone!"**

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "Villages and Countrysides Game" on cardstock, one per child. Print "Game Piece" on cardstock and cut, one cutout per child. Write each child's name on their bag.

During the Activity: Encourage children to color their game board and the game pieces. Retell the Bible Story by playing the game together. Pack up each child's game board, game pieces, and their die.

After the Activity: Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "Come sit with me! I have a super fun game for us to make and play to help us remember today's Bible Story."

During the Activity: "You have a game board (*hold up a game board*) and a Jesus game piece to color. (*Pause.*) Great job! Let me help you fold your game piece. (*Fold each child's game piece.*) Now let's play the game. Put Jesus on your game board down here (*point*) and let's get ready to play. (*Roll the die.*) Move Jesus [number] of spots. (*Pause.*) Look around the gameboard. Where is Jesus? He's in the [towns, villages, countryside]! Jesus helped people here. Let's roll and move Jesus to other places. (*Continue until Jesus gets to the other end.*) Great job friends! Everywhere Jesus went, He did amazing things to help people—because Jesus loves and cares about everyone!

"Jesus went to help people in lots of different places. Sometimes, Jesus went where people were excited to see Him. One day, Jesus and His friends, the disciples, rowed across a lake. When they got to the other side, the people who lived there saw that Jesus had come. 'Jesus is here! Jesus is here!' they shouted. Wherever Jesus went on this side of the lake—small towns, big towns, or out into the countryside—people ran throughout the area and carried their sick friends on mats to Jesus. They knew that Jesus cared about them and could help them. And here's the amazing thing: Jesus is so powerful that some sick person could be healed just by touching Jesus' clothes. People crowded around Jesus to reach for His robe—and Jesus healed every single person who touched Him in one town."

After the Activity: "Jesus' love is wide enough for people who live in big towns and little villages. It's long enough for people who are sick and hurting. Jesus' love is high enough for those who love Him. And it's deep enough even for those who don't like Him because **[Bottom Line] Jesus cares about everyone.**

Watch Your Heartbeat | Made to Think *Uses Minimal Supplies

What You Need

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "Allergy Alert Poster" on cardstock, list marshmallows and post at the door. Stick a toothpick into the center of the marshmallow. At the top of the toothpick, place a heart sticker on each side, sandwiching the toothpick in between.

During the Activity: Ask children to hold out one arm with their wrist up. Find each child's pulse then place the marshmallow on top of the pulse area. Ask child to keep their arm super still. Leader may want to hold child's arm to help keep it still. Watch the marshmallow toothpick move to the beat of their heart. Continue with each child. Dispose of the marshmallow toothpick when you are finished with the activity.

After the Activity: Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "Everyone come sit with me. Did you know that you could feel your heartbeat? (*Pause for responses.*) You can! Have any of you ever felt your heartbeat? (*Pause for responses.*) Today we are going to feel and see our heartbeat! I'm so excited for you to see!"




During the Activity: "Okay, let's start! I made this funny heartbeat detector. (*Hold up the marshmallow toothpick.*) This isn't for eating; it's only for our eyes to watch. [Child's name], hold out your arm like this. (*Demonstrate.*) I'm going to feel your wrist to find your heartbeat, yes! Your wrist is just one of the places you can feel your heartbeat. Isn't that cool?! Okay! I found it! (*Place the marshmallow on the spot.*) Everybody watch [child's name]'s wrist. (*Hold child's arm if needed, then pause.*) Wow! Did you see it move? (*Pause for responses.*) You saw [child's name]'s heart beating! Amazing! Who wants to see their heart beat next? (*Pause for responses.*) Fantastic! Here we go! (*Continue with each child.*) That was so neat seeing everyone's heartbeat!"

After the Activity: "With every beat of your heart, Jesus loves and cares about each and every one of you. Who does Jesus care about? **[Bottom Line] Jesus cares about everyone.** That's right, let's say it again. Who does Jesus care about? **[Bottom Line] Jesus cares about everyone.**"

What You Need

-  "Everyone, Everywhere Corners" Activity 1 Page
-  Cardstock 1

EveryChild tips

- In place of running, encourage children to move in an alternative way so all children can participate.

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "Everyone, Everywhere Corners" on cardstock, one set per Small Group. Tape the pictures around the room on the walls at child's height.

During the Activity: Encourage children to run to the corner you call out. When everyone gets to the corner, ask children to say the Bottom Line. Continue with each of the corners. Then if time and interest allow, let children run to any of the corners they desire and say the Bottom Line.

After the Activity: Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "Friends! Meet me in the middle of the room. (Pause.) There are different pictures around the room, do you see them? (Point to the four pictures.) Let's play a game with those pictures."

During the Activity: "Do you see the picture of the playground? (Point to the playground picture.) When I say go, I want you to run to the picture. Ready, set, GO! (Pause.) Hooray! You made it! Tell me friends, who cares about everyone at the playground? (Pause.) That's right **[Bottom Line] Jesus cares about everyone** at the playground! Who does Jesus care about? **[Bottom Line] Jesus cares about everyone.** Great job! Come back to the middle with me. (Pause.) Now look for the picture of grocery store. You can run to it when I say go. Ready, set, GO! (Pause.) Hooray! You made it! Tell me friends, who cares about everyone at the grocery store? (Pause.) That's right **[Bottom Line] Jesus cares about everyone** at the grocery store! Who does Jesus care about? **[Bottom Line] Jesus cares about everyone.** (Continue with each picture and repeat. Then allow children to run to whichever picture they want and say the **Bottom Line.**) Great job, friends! Come back to the middle and sit with me."

After the Activity: "All the places we ran to today; the playground, the grocery store, the doctor's office, the school, even when we ran right back here, to the middle, Jesus cares about everyone everywhere we went! In our Bible Story, everywhere Jesus went, small towns, big towns, or out into the countryside, He did amazing things to help people, because Jesus loves and cares about everyone! People ran and carried their sick friends on mats to Jesus. And others simply touched Jesus' robe and were healed.

Jesus' love is wide, and long, and high, and deep enough for everyone because Jesus loves and cares about everyone. **Who does Jesus care about? [Bottom Line] Jesus cares about everyone.**

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "Flat Jesus" on 11-inch x 17-inch paper, one per child. *Optional:* For each child, cut out around Jesus. Write each child's name on their paper.

During the Activity: Give each child a picture to decorate. *Optional:* Take a picture of each child with their picture of Jesus and either print or text/email to their parent/guardian.

After the Activity: Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "Hello friends! Come to the table and let's get ready to make some super fun story art to take home today."

During the Activity: "Tell me who this is a picture of. (Pause for responses.) That's right! It's a big picture of Jesus! Color your picture as I review today's story. Today, we learned that wherever Jesus went, He did amazing things to help people. Wherever Jesus went, small towns, big towns, or out into the countryside, people ran throughout the area and carried their sick friends on mats to Jesus. They knew that Jesus cared about them and could help them. Friends, Jesus is so powerful that sometimes just touching Jesus' clothes could heal the sick. In one town, people crowded around Jesus to reach for His robe, and Jesus healed every single person who touched His clothes. Jesus loves and cares about everyone!"

After the Activity: "You can take your picture of Jesus everywhere you go and tell people in those places that Jesus loves them and cares about them. **[Bottom Line] Jesus cares about everyone.** Who does Jesus care about?**[Bottom Line] Jesus cares about everyone!"**

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "Memory Verse Card" on cardstock and cut one per Small Group. Place one card in your Bible at Ephesians 3:18.

Note: Keep this card in your Bible all month long. Pour pom-poms into the bowl/bin. Carry the bowl/bin and jar with you to your Small Group area.

Encourage the children to point to different places and people in the room as you lead them to your Small Group spot. Sit down and gather the children around you.

During the Activity: Review the Bible Story and the Memory Verse Hand Motions. Ask the children to name a person that Jesus cares about and place a pom-pom in the jar for that person while you write the names in the journal. Continue until the jar is full of pom-poms.

After the Activity: Pray with the children using the list you made in the journal.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "It's Small Group time! Today, we are going to point to all the different places and people in our room. Let's go! Point to the block area. (*Point.*) Point to the kitchen center. (*Point.*) Point to our friend [leader/child's name]! (*Point.*) Keep going all the way to our Small Group spot because Jesus cares about everyone everywhere! (*Continue with places and people.*) We made it! Now we can sit down and talk about today's Bible Story. One, two, three, sit down with me!"

During the Activity: (Open the Bible and lay it in front of the children.) "In our Bible Story today, we heard how Jesus did amazing things to help people everywhere He went. Jesus went to help people in lots of different places, small towns, big towns, or out into the countryside. People ran throughout the area and carried their sick friends on mats to Jesus because they knew that Jesus cared about them and could help them. Jesus is so powerful that a sick person could be healed, just by touching Jesus' clothes. People crowded around Jesus to reach for His robe and Jesus healed every single person who touched Him.

"The Bible verse we are learning talks about how big Jesus' love is for us. It says, 'How wide (*stretch arms out wide*) and long (*stretch arms forward*) and high (*reach arms up*) and deep (*crouch down low*) is the love of Christ. (*Hug yourself.*) Ephesians 3:18 (*open hands like a book.*) Did you hear that? Jesus loves us wide, (*stretch arms out wide*), and long (*stretch arms forward*), and high (*reach arms up*), and deep! (*Crouch down low.*) Jesus loves everyone, everywhere that much because **[Bottom Line] Jesus cares about everyone.** Let's stand up and say that Bible verse together! Just say what I say and do what I do! 'How

wide (*stretch arms out wide*) and long (*stretch arms forward*) and high (*reach arms up*) and deep (*crouch down low*) is the love of Christ. (*Hug yourself.*) Ephesians 3:18 (*open hands like a book*).

"Yay! (*Clap.*) I'm so glad that Jesus loves and cares about everyone everywhere! Let's sit down so we can name different people who Jesus cares about. As you name someone, place a pom-pom in the jar, and I'll write those names in our prayer journal. (*Open journal. Remember to print, as you write in the journal, so the children can recognize their names and the letters.*) In our Bible Story, Jesus cared for everyone, everywhere He went. Look at our jar! It's filled to the top! You added beautiful colored pom-poms for each person you named that Jesus cares about. We could keep adding more and more pom-poms for the people that Jesus cares about because Jesus cares about everyone!"

After the Activity: "Let's pray. Dear God, thank You for all the people You care about. We named so many people today as we filled our jar. What a great reminder that You care about everyone! We love You, God. In Jesus' name, Amen."
