## Watch Me Grow Chart | Made to Create \*Uses Minimal Supplies\*

### What You Need

	11-inch x 17-inch paper	1
	Cardstock, one quarter of a piece per child	1
	Washable green ink pads, one for every three children	1
	Clear tape	1
	Baby wipes	1
	Scissors	1
	Permanent marker	1
	Optional: Green dot markers in place of green washable ink pad	Several
	"Growth Chart" Activity Page	1
	"Fun at Home" Activity Page	1



### EveryChild tips

- Provide green dot stickers or dot markers for children with sensory sensitivities and may not want to touch the ink.

### What You Do:

**Before the Activity:** Print "Growth Chart" on 11-inch x 17-inch paper and cut one set per child. Copy "Fun at Home" on cardstock and cut one note per child. Align each child's strips of paper and tape the ends together to make a long strip. Write each child's name on their paper.

**During the Activity:** Give each child a growth chart. Show them how to press their thumb or finger onto the green ink pad and then press it onto the leaves on their chart, filling them in. Clean hands as needed.

**After the Activity:** Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

### What You Say:

**Before the Activity:** "We've talked about how small seeds grow into big things. YOU are growing, too! Let's make a special chart to see how you grow."

**During the Activity:** "This is your very own 'Watch Me Grow' chart. Let's add some green to the leaves on your paper. You can use your finger to make a fingerprint on each leaf! (*Demonstrate.*) Press and lift! Look at that! You are filling in the leaves, making your tree grow. You are growing bigger and stronger every day, too!"

**After the Activity:** "Your growth charts look wonderful! You can take these home, and your family can use them to see how big you grow. The story that Jesus told about the mustard seed shows us how God's kingdom grows. It can start small, but it grows big enough for everyone. When we follow Jesus, we become a part of God's kingdom! Jesus teaches us everything we need to know so you and I can be a part of God's kingdom. **[Bottom Line] I can be part of God's kingdom. Who can be part of God's kingdom? [Bottom Line] I can be part of God's kingdom!**"

# Getting Ready | 2's Small Group

## GETTING READY

Here's everything you need to know to get ready for this week.

### Social

#### 1. Seed Shakers

*Made to Move*

##### What You Need:

- Plastic fillable eggs, one per child
- Small items to put inside (e.g. rice, mustard seeds), one bag per Small Group
- Clear packing tape, one roll per Small Group

##### Optional EveryChild Supplies

- Cotton balls or other soft-sounding contents

##### What You Do:

- Fill each plastic egg with a few small items and securely tape them shut, one for each child and leader.

#### 2. Garden Sensory Bin

*Made to Play*

##### What You Need:

- Large, shallow bin, one per Small Group
- Brown shredded paper, several bags per Small Group
- Small plastic flowerpots, one for every three children
- Small toy shovels, one for every three children
- Silk flowers, one for every three children
- Watering can, one per Small Group

##### What You Do:

- Fill the bin with the shredded paper.
- Stick the silk flowers into the "dirt" and place the pots and shovels next to the bin.

#### 3. Special Story Corner

*Made to Imagine*

##### What You Need:

- Preschool Bible, one per Small Group
- Small tent, or baby pool, one per Small Group
- Blankets, several per Small Group
- Pillows, several per Small Group
- Board books about gardens or growing things, several per Small Group

##### What You Do:

- Set up a cozy corner with a tent, baby pool, blankets, and pillows to feel like a special, quiet reading nook.

- Create a "starting line" with painter's tape on the opposite side of the room.

**What You Do:**

- Copy "Fun at Home" on cardstock and cut, one note per child.

- Align each child's strips of paper and tape the ends together to make a long strip.
- Write each child's name on their paper.

- Copy the Memory Verse Card to hand out or make available to parents.
- Copy "Going Home" and hang it on the door where Small Group Leaders can reference and remind parents of the Bottom Line and Memory Verse as parents pick up their children.
