My Piggy Bank | Made to Create *Uses Minimal Supplies*

What You Need

	Cardstock, one and a quarter piece per child	1
	A4 envelopes	1
	Crayons or dot markers	Several

	VELCRO® adhesive dots	1

EveryChild tips

- Use dot markers, which are great for little hands that are still developing the strength and coordination to hold a crayon.
- Offer large, easy-to-peel stickers for a fun and successful decorating experience.

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "My Piggy Bank" on cardstock and cut one per child and leader. Print "Coin Cutout" on cardstock and cut one per child and leader. Glue each piggy bank cutout to the front of an envelope, making sure the slot is in the main part of the envelope. Lift the flap and cut the dotted lines along the "slot," making sure to cut through the Activity Page and the envelope. Write each child's name on their paper.

During the Activity: Encourage children to color their piggy bank while you color. When they are done, help each child attach one side of the VELCRO dot on the edge of the flap and the other side of the VELCRO dot on the envelope where the flap aligns. Attach the VELCRO to your envelope as well.

After the Activity: Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "Come to the table with me, friends! We are going to make our very own piggy bank to help us remember today's Bible Story."

During the Activity: "Here is your piggy! (Give each child a prepared piggy bank.) Let's make it super colorful. You can use the crayons or markers to decorate your piggy. (Allow time to decorate.) Your piggies look so happy and colorful! See this slot right here? That is where you can slide your money in. (Slide the coin cutout into the slot.) Your turn! (Give each child a coin cutout.) And when you want to take your money out, (turn the piggy bank around and lift the flap) look! It's right there! (Pull out the coin cutout.)"

After the Activity: "The son in our story spent all his money and was very sad. But his dad loved him no matter what and was so happy when he came home. God loves us like that, too! God loves us no matter what and is always happy when we come to Him. He wants everyone to be a part of His kingdom. You can be part of God's kingdom and **[Bottom Line] I can be part of God's kingdom.**"

GETTING READY

Here's everything you need to know to get ready for this week.

Social

1. Pack and Go

Made to Move

What You Need:

- Preschool Bible, one per Small Group
- Small rolling suitcase or child's suitcase on wheels, one per Small Group
- Lightweight items (e.g. stuffed animal, soft block, blanket, etc.), several per Small Group

2. Heart Match

Made to Play

What You Need:

- Butcher paper, one per Small Group
- Foam hearts in a variety of colors, twenty-five of each color per Small Group
- Washable markers in the same colors as the hearts, one of each color per Small Group
- Masking tape, one roll per Small Group

What You Do:

- Cover table with butcher paper and tape it down.
- Draw several large heart outlines on the paper in different colors.
- Place the foam hearts in a pile on the table.

3. Feed the Pigs*

Made to Explore

What You Need:

- "Allergy Alert Poster", one per Small Group
- Cardstock, one piece per Small Group
- Shallow plastic bin, one per Small Group
- Dry oatmeal, one large container per Small Group
- Toy pigs, several per Small Group
- Plastic spoons, one for every three children
- Plastic tablecloth, one per Small Group
- Baby wipes, one package per Small Group

Optional EveryChild Supplies:

- *Gloves, one pair per child*

What You Do:

- Copy "Allergy Alert Poster" on cardstock, list oatmeal and post at the door.
- Spread the tablecloth over the table and place the bin on top.
- Fill the bin with a layer of oatmeal.
- Place the toy pigs and spoons in the bin.

What You Do:

- Large, shallow plastic container, one per Small Group
- Little People® men, two per Small Group
- Toy pigs, several per Small Group
- Toy house, one per Small Group
- Confetti, one bag per Small Group

What You Do:

- Put the container and other items in your activity area.
- Place the house in one corner of the container.

- "My Piggy Bank" Activity Page, one per child

- Glue sticks, several per Small Group
- VELCRO® adhesive dots, one per child
- Scissors, one pair per Small Group

What You Do:

- Print "My Piggy Bank" on cardstock and cut, one per child and leader.

- Print "Coin Cutout" on cardstock and cut, one cutout per child and leader.
- Glue each piggy bank cutout to the front of an envelope making sure the slot is in the main part of the envelope.
- Lift the flap and cut the dotted lines along the "slot" making sure to cut through the Activity Page and the envelope.
- Write each child's name on their paper.

Home: Prompting Action Beyond the Experience

- Make copies on cardstock or email this week's Parent Cue Card.
- Copy the Memory Verse Card to hand out or make available to parents.
- Copy "Going Home" and hang it on the door where Small Group Leaders can reference and remind parents of the Bottom Line and Memory Verse as parents pick up their children.
