Key Question: Who can be a part of God's kingdom?

Bottom Line: I can be a part of God's kingdom.

Memory Verse: "Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven." • Matthew 6:10 NIV

What You Need

	Avery® Labels #5163 or equivalent	1

	Jewel stickers	5

	Optional: Scalloped bulletin board border, scissors, stapler, and clear tape in place of paper crowns	Several

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "Kingdom Crown Sticker" on label paper, one sticker per child. Write each child's name on their crown.

During the Activity: Give each child a crown and let them decorate it with coloring supplies, jewel stickers, and stamps. When they are done, ask children to add their Kingdom Crown Sticker (with the Bottom Line) to the middle of their crown. Assemble each child's crown and help them to place it on their head.

After the Activity: Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "The two parables in our Bible Story today teach us that loving God and His kingdom is the most important thing. It comes first! Let's make a crown to help us remember to put God first."

During the Activity: "You can decorate your crown and make it super special with markers, jewels, or stamps. *(Pause.)* Wow! These are beautiful! Now add your label to your crown. It tells you where to look in the Bible to find our story today and says, **[Bottom Line] I can be part of God's kingdom.**

(Measure the crowns around each child's head and secure the ends together by interlocking the notch.) Now you can wear your crown as we review today's Bible Story."

After the Activity: "Your crowns show everyone that you can be part of God's kingdom. Jesus wanted His friends to know that God's kingdom was most important! Being loved by God and loving Him back is the most important thing we can do. **Who can be part of God's kingdom? [Bottom Line] I can be part of God's kingdom!**"

GETTING READY

Here's everything you need to know to get ready for this week.

Social

1. Tunnel Treasure

Made to Move

What You Need:

- "Tunnel Treasure" Activity Page, one per Small Group
- Cardstock, one piece per Small Group
- Pop-up tunnel, one per Small Group
- Masking tape, one roll per Small Group

Optional EveryChild Supplies:

- Two tall chairs
- Sheet

What You Do:

- Print "Treasure Chest" on cardstock, one per Small Group.
- Place the tunnel in an open area.
- Tape the treasure chest with the image facing into the tunnel, so that it hangs down from the top of one end.

2. Find the Pearl

Made to Play

What You Need:

- Empty, clear plastic bottle with lid, one per Small Group
- Dry rice, one bag per Small Group
- Iridescent glitter, one bottle per Small Group
- White sparkly pom-pom, one per Small Group
- Duct tape, one roll per Small Group

What You Do:

- Fill the bottle about three-quarters full of dried rice.
- Add glitter and one white pom-pom.
- Replace the lid on the bottle and secure it with a piece of duct tape.

3. Special Necklaces

What You Need:

- Variety of plastic, chunky, beaded necklaces (such as Mardi Gras beads), including at least one that is all white or pearly. One per child
- Preschool-safe standing mirror, one per Small Group

What You Need:

- "Memory Verse Stickers" Activity Page, one per child
- Avery Labels #22830 or equivalent, one sticker per child
- Treasure chest/box, one per Small Group

- Scissors, one pair per Small Group

What You Do:

- Print "Memory Verse Stickers" on label paper, one sticker per child.
- Remove the label paper border and cut into individual stickers.
- Place the stickers in the treasure chest.

- Small treasure chest, one per Small Group
- Small organza drawstring bag, one per Small Group
- Plastic coins, several per Small Group
- White sparkly pom-pom, one per Small Group

What You Do:

- Place the coins in the bag and close.
- Put the bag of coins and the pom-pom inside the treasure box.

What You Do:

- Print "Kingdom Crown Sticker" on label paper, one sticker per child.
- Write each child's name on their crown.

- Copy the Memory Verse Card to hand out or make available to parents.
- Copy "Going Home" and hang it on the door where Small Group Leaders can reference and remind parents of the Bottom Line and Memory Verse as parents pick up their children.
