TABLE TIME

VERSE HEADBAND

Supplies:

1. “Verse Headband – Label” Activity Page (1 label per child, printed on OL125 labels)
2. “Verse Headband – Stickers” Activity Page (multiple sheets, printed on OL1330 labels)
3. Sentence strips (1 per child, 24" x 3")
4. Colorful tissue paper squares
5. Glue sticks
6. Tape

How-To:

1. Give each child a sentence strip.
2. Help them place a Bible verse label in the middle of their sentence strip.
3. Encourage them to decorate their sentence strip with heart stickers and tissue paper.
4. Measure the sentence strip to the child’s head, and tape the ends together to create a headband.

Say This:

Before the Activity:

Rahab was kind and loving to the two spies by helping them. Let’s make a special headband to wear to help us remember that.

During the Activity:

Everyone gets a strip of paper (*hold up sentence strip*). First, let’s add this sticker with our Bible verse on it. Let’s say our Bible verse together: “Love your neighbor as yourself” Matthew 22:39. Let’s say that one more time: “Love your neighbor as yourself” Matthew 22:39. Great job!

Okay, now let’s decorate with heart stickers and tissue paper. When you’re finished decorating, a leader will tape the ends together to create a headband for you to wear home.

After the Activity:

When you wear your headband, remember that Rahab loved others by helping them, and you can too!
