Bible Story: Wonderfully Me • Genesis 1:27; Psalm 139:13-14

Key Question: Who made me wonderful?

Bottom Line: God made me wonderful.

Memory Verse: How you made me is amazing and wonderful. • Psalm 139:14 Nlrv

Wonderful Frame | Made to Create *Uses Minimal Supplies*

What You Need

	"Wonderful Frame" Activity Page	1
	Jumbo craft sticks	Several
	Craft knife	1
	Crayons or markers	Several
	Stickers	Several
	Self-inking stamps	Several
	Masking tape	1

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print "Wonderful Frame" on cardstock, one per child. Cut out the inside of each child's frame. Write each child's name on their frame.

During the Activity: Encourage children to decorate their frame. Tape a craft stick to the back of their frame. Ask children to hold their frame up to their face.

After the Activity: Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: "Come on over to the table, artists! Our Bible Story says God made you amazing and wonderful. We are going to make a special picture frame to show off God's wonderful creation—YOU!"

During the Activity: "Here is your very own picture frame. The first thing we need to do is make it super special and beautiful, just like you! You can use markers, stickers, and stamps to decorate your frame. *(Allow children time to decorate.)* Wow, your frames look amazing! They are so colorful and unique. Now, we need to add a handle so you can hold it up. I'm going to tape a craft stick right here on the back. *(Attach a craft stick to the bottom of each frame.)* Perfect! Now for the best part. Let's see what picture goes inside this frame. Hold it up to your face ... It's YOU! You are the wonderful picture! Look at all my wonderful friends!" *(Encourage children to hold the frames up and peek at each other through them.)*

After the Activity: "Your wonderful frames are the perfect way to show off God's amazing creation! Our story reminds us that God made every single part of you, and He thinks you are just perfect. Remember, no matter what, God made you wonderful! **Who made you wonderful? [Bottom Line] God made me wonderful!"**

What You Need:

- "Wonderful Frame" Activity Page, one per child
- Cardstock, one piece per child
- Jumbo craft sticks, one per child
- Craft knife, one per Small Group
- Crayons or markers, several per child
- Stickers, several per child
- Self-inking stamps, several per Small Group
- Masking tape, one roll per child

What You Do:

- Print "Wonderful Frame" on cardstock, one per child.
- Cut out the inside of each child's frame.
- Write each child's name on their frame.

Home: Prompting Action Beyond the Experience

- Make copies on cardstock or email this week's Parent Cue Card.
- Copy the Memory Verse Card to hand out or make available to parents.
- Copy "Going Home" and hang it on the door where Small Group Leaders can reference and remind parents of the Bottom Line and Memory Verse as parents pick up their children.
