Sentence Prayers

Why do sentence prayers?

1. Helps new believers learn how to pray.
2. It helps those that are not comfortable praying in public.
3. It can be intimidating when you have people that can speak long winded prayers verses those that can barely speak at all. This levels the playing field.
4. Doing sentence prayers is NOT less spiritual. In fact, it takes pressure off of the need to perform.
5. You can do sentence prayers by yourself or in a group setting.
6. This style may help you focus better.
