I can do all things through Christ

*Book Excerpt: "Greatness Through Persecution" by Evg. William Rameau

(June 23, 1940 – November 12, 1994) [54 Years Old]*

Would you chase an impossible dream while battling childhood paralysis and life-threatening illnesses? That's exactly what young Wilma Rudolph did. Born prematurely on June 23, 1940, to Blanche and Ed Rudolph in Saint Bethlehem, Tennessee, Wilma faced monumental challenges from the start. She contracted pneumonia, scarlet fever, and polio as a child, leaving her with a paralyzed left leg. Doctors told her she would never walk again without braces.

Amidst these struggles, Wilma found strength in her faith and family. When she asked her parents, "Will I ever be able to run and play like the other children?" they responded with unwavering belief:

"Honey, you only have to believe. If you believe, God will make it happen." Her mother's faith became a guiding light, inspiring Wilma to fight for her future.

The segregated South compounded Wilma's challenges. As a young Black girl, she was denied treatment at white hospitals. Despite these barriers, her family ensured she received physical therapy, often traveling great distances for care. Her determination to walk without braces culminated in a powerful moment during a Sunday church service. Wilma walked shakily but triumphantly down the aisle without her braces, drawing gasps from the congregation.

"My doctor told me I would never walk again. My mother told me I would. I believed my mother," she later said. This belief in her own potential laid the foundation for a journey that would take her from the cotton fields of Tennessee to the Olympic podium.

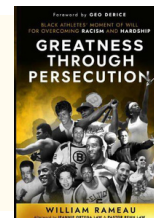
Devotional: Wilma Rudolph's story shows us the power of faith and belief spoken into a life. When doctors declared impossibility, her mother's words gave her hope: "Honey, you only have to believe. If you believe, God will make it happen." Wilma chose to hold onto her mother's voice instead of the voices of doubt.

As believers, we are called to do the same; but instead of fixing our eyes on the voices of this world, we fix our eyes on Jesus, "the author and finisher of our faith" (Hebrews 12:2). The world is filled with chaos, lies, and false promises. If we are not careful, we can be deceived by "every wind of doctrine" (Ephesians 4:14) or lulled into discouragement by voices that say it cannot be done. But Scripture reminds us, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" (Philippians 4:13). Just as Wilma believed her mother's unwavering voice, we must choose to believe the unchanging Word of God above the noise of this world. Jesus warned that in the last days, "false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect" (Matthew 24:24). This is why discernment is critical. We anchor ourselves in God's truth, refusing to let the lies of culture, fear, or doubt shape our faith. Family of God, let us press forward with the confidence that Christ's strength is enough. Just as Wilma walked down that church aisle without her braces, we too can walk boldly in faith... casting off the things that once held us back, and running the race set before us with endurance, fixing our eyes on Jesus (Hebrews 12:1–2).

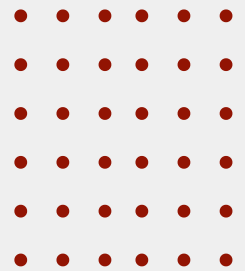
