The ACBC training program not only enables you to help others but will minister personally to your own soul and grow you up in the Lord and the knowledge of His Word.

Marriage Mentoring

Are you newly married and feel you would like a little guidance as your relationship grows and changes? Perhaps you have been married long enough that busyness and complacency has created drift and your relationship is 'just OK'. Have you lost a child, in a blended family, or other major life event and would like to connect with another couple who understands the unique challenges you face? Maybe you are in a healthy marriage but want it to be even better.

LBC has trained marriage mentors with life experiences to encourage you no matter how you would describe your marriage. Mentors will be there to cheer you when you are doing well and help give attention to areas you want to strengthen so that small irritations don't become major issues. There is usually a lot of laughter and sometimes tears, as couples share from their hearts.

The plan is for a mentor and mentee couple to meet once a month for a year to explore topics such as Money, Pace and Priorities, Gratitude and Forgiveness and others. You choose the topic each month.

- LBC app - Open app. Beginning January 1, 2026, at the bottom, tap on the 'Bible' icon. Tap on 'Plan' at the lower part of your screen. The Plan will give you the reading assignment for the day. Simply tap on the reading assignment and the app will redirect you to the passage. You may read the passage or listen audibly. The plan will populate over time.
