Start talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- Who are some of the most selfless people you know? What have you learned from them?

Start thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- Read Haggai 1:6 at the bottom of the page. Have you ever been able to relate to this verse—or can you right now? How so?
- What’s the scariest thing about giving more of what you have?

Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- How would you describe your mindset around finances? How has this been impacted by your past, childhood, or others’ opinions about finances ?
- What mindset would you like to have about finances?
- Have you ever given so much away that it scared you? If so, what happened next (if you feel comfortable sharing the story)?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

God, You are a big-hearted and grace-filled God! We want to joyfully give our first and best back to You. Show us where we can give more extravagantly to others. Holy Spirit, give us the courage to grow in generosity. Amen.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- What’s your next step toward learning to trust God with the area of finances? Say it out loud even if it scares you.
- Ask God in prayer this week for specific opportunities to be generous. Then, obey and watch what He does.
