Adventure Week

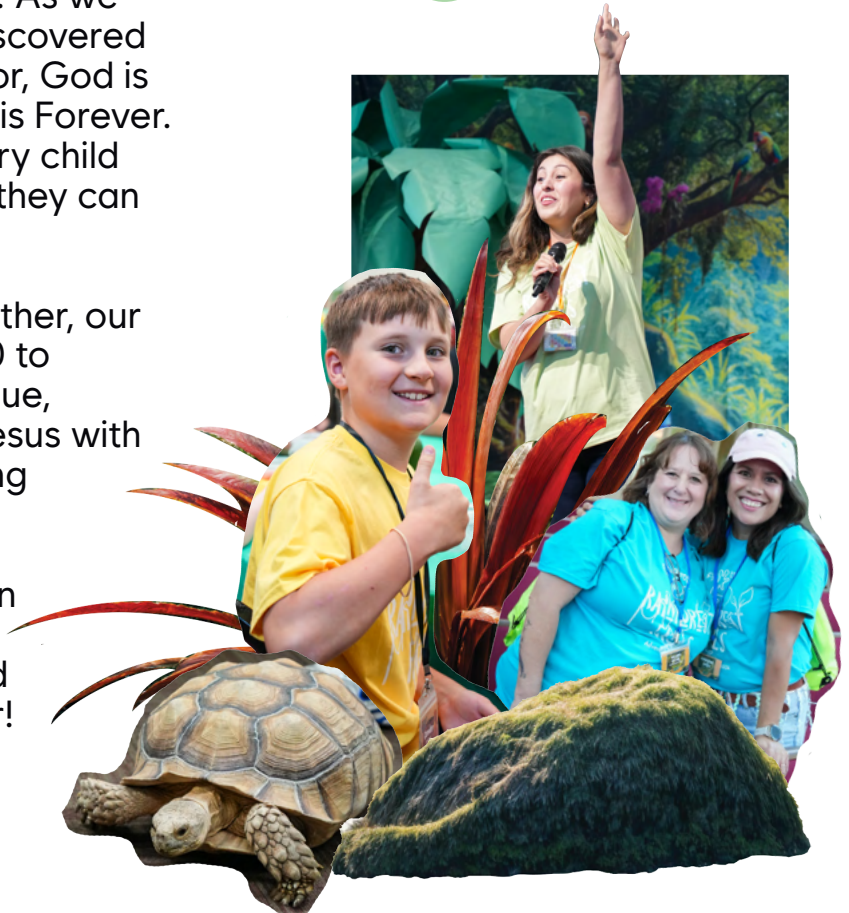

Missionaries Passage: Numbers 12:1-16

By the time we get to the book of Numbers, Moses has matured in his role as Israel's leader. Time and again, we see Moses humbly doing as God said. Even in the face of opposition from his brother and sister, Moses responded humbly. He was content to let God handle it. And handle it He did. Moses had already had his humbling experiences; now it was his siblings' turn. Miriam, it seems, took the brunt of the punishment for her and Aaron's opposition to Moses. Aaron, though, was affected too, watching his sister suddenly contract leprosy. Humility is learned and is necessary in the service of God. Moses did not lash out at his brother and sister; instead, he watched as God worked in them through pain. Has God ever used a difficult or hurtful time in your life to develop humility in you? Pray God would help you not let any suffering go to waste, but let it build up your dependence on Him.

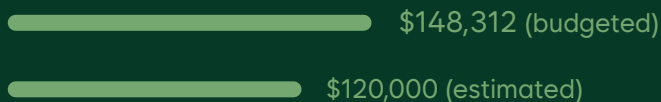
