

## Today's Suggested Schedule—March 2026, Week 1

**Today's Bible Story:** Water to Wine • John 2:1-11  
Nothing is too hard for Jesus.

**Key Question:** Who is amazing?

**Bottom Line:** Jesus is amazing.

**Memory Verse:** *"We have seen amazing things today!"* (Luke 5:26 NLT).

## Groups

### 1. Memory Verse with Motions

#### What You Need:

- No supplies needed

#### What You Do:

*Before the Activity:* Say the Memory Verse and demonstrate the motions for the children.

*During the Activity:* Teach the Memory Verse motions. Invite the children to do them with you several times.

*After the Activity:* Connect the Memory Verse to the Bottom Line.

#### What You Say:

*Before the Activity:* “Friends, come stand with me, and let me tell you our brand-new Memory Verse! Ready to hear it? It goes like this. ‘We have seen (*point to self*) amazing things today!’ (*Hands like binoculars, open and shut.*) Luke 5:26 (*open hands like a book.*)”

*During the Activity:* “Now, let’s learn the motions. The first part of our verse says: ‘We have seen.’ (*Point to self.*) Put your pointer finger up and tap your chest like this (*pointer finger up, then tap your chest*) and say, ‘We have seen.’ (*Repeat with children.*) Great job!

“The next part of our verse says: ‘Amazing things today.’ (*Hands like binoculars, open and shut.*) Make circles with both hands and put them up to your eyes like this (*put both your hands to your eyes like binoculars or glasses*). Open and close them and say, ‘amazing things today.’ (*Repeat with children.*) Wonderful! Now let’s put that together. ‘We have seen (*point to self*) amazing things today!’ (*Hands like binoculars, open and shut.*) Great job!

“Now the last part is: ‘Luke 5:26.’ (*Open hands like a book.*) Put your hands together in front of you and open them like you are opening a book (*open hands like a book*) and say: Luke 5:26. (*Repeat with children.*) Great job! I think we are ready to do it all together! Ready friends? ‘We have seen (*point to self*) amazing things today! (*Hands like binoculars, open and shut.*) Luke 5:26 (*open hands like a book*). Nice job. Let’s do it again!” (*Repeat several times.*)

*After the Activity:* “The Bible teaches us that nothing is too hard for Jesus because **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!** In today’s Bible Story, Jesus did something amazing! Jesus turned water into wine! Jesus did something that no one else can do because Jesus is God’s Son. **Who is amazing? [Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!**”

## 2. Craft- Amazing Award



### What You Need:

- “Amazing Award” Activity Page
- Crayons OR dot markers
- Yarn
- Permanent marker

### What You Do:

*Before the Activity:* Write their name.

*During the Activity:* Encourage children to decorate their paper, then thread the yarn through the hole and knot. Help children put their awards on, then review the Bible Story.

*After the Activity:* Connect the Bottom Line to the Bible Story.

### What You Say:

*Before the Activity:* “Friends, come sit at the table with me and let’s make some amazing awards!”

*During the Activity:* “The words on your award say **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!** Use the markers and stamps to decorate your award. *(Pause.)* Wow! These look great! Let’s add some yarn so you can wear your amazing awards and remember that **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!** *(Thread the yarn through the hole in each child’s award and knot the ends. Place it around the child’s neck.)* In today’s true story from the Bible, we heard how Jesus did something amazing! Jesus and His friends, the disciples, were at a wedding, and so was Mary, the mother of Jesus. There was special food, and a special drink called wine. Mary saw that the wine was out, so she went to Jesus and asked Him for help. Jesus told the servants to fill six jars with water. Then Jesus turned the water into wine! Amazing!”

*After the Activity:* “Jesus did something that no one else can do because Jesus is God’s Son. **[Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing! Who is amazing? [Bottom Line] Jesus is amazing!**”
