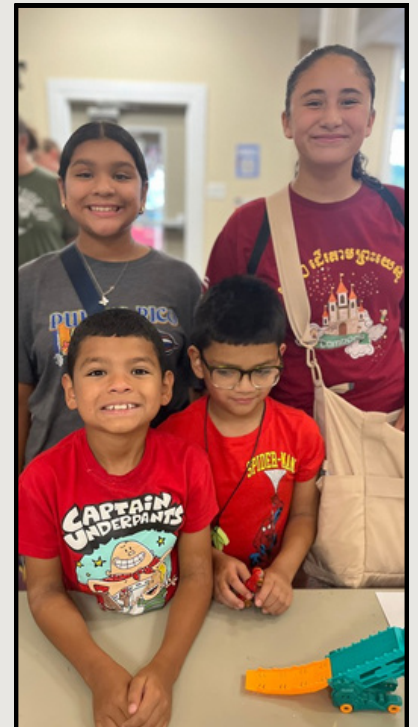

We honor your gifts with faithful stewardship, ethical business practices, and full accountability so that PBC's financial integrity remains beyond reproach.

Financial Report: Period Ending August 31, 2026

This report provides a summary of the church's financial status for the fiscal year to date through August 31, 2026 (July 1 – August 31, 2026).

FINANCE REPORT

REPORT SUBMITTED AUGUST 31ST BY AMY VANNOSTRAND

Budgetary Observations:

As we review the period through August 31st under our July 1st to June 30th fiscal year model, our financial standing remains positive and on solid footing.

Summer months often bring seasonal shifts in attendance and giving patterns across church ministries. Despite these typical summer trends, tithes reached **\$47,205.70** (approx. 15% of our annual projection), and careful expense management kept overall expenditures to **\$55,572.07**. This allowed the church to remain in the black with a net positive balance of **\$149.43**.

As our ministry programs, youth activities, and community outreach resume full operations heading into the fall, we anticipate both giving and event activity to pick up into the second quarter.

Mission Team Quarterly Report- Sept. 2026

The current Mission Team members are Chris Mayer (Secretary/coordinator), Jay and Denise Fiet, Linda Singer, Jean Pyzik and Darby Jensen. We meet on the 1st Tuesday of each month, to discuss any missionary needs that arise, updates on missionaries, mission funds and distribution, and the annual fall conference. If you are interested in being on the mission team, let Chris or one of the other members know. You can even sit in on a meeting to check it out!

Mission Funds: As of August 2026, we have \$8,365.25 in the Missions Faith Promise Account.

In July, we gave \$1,750.00 towards the Mission Trip to Ecuador. No other funds have been allocated this quarter.

Missionary Support: Beginning July first, the church started supporting Pastor Mark and Valerie Appell for \$500 per month. They will be serving in France with Christar Ministries. No other new support has been added at this time. We currently support 19 Field Workers and Ministries for a total of \$4,692.00 monthly, or \$50,804.00 yearly, which comes out of the regular budget. (See the Monthly Support page)

Mission Trips: A group of young people and adults led by Pastor Joedan went to Ecuador to serve with Jeff and Deanne Davoll July 9-18, 2026. Much was accomplished through street evangelism, teaching English in schools, and helping with the Davoll's church ministry. There is also a trip to Brazil planned for this November, to help Roberto and Anna DeLucia in their ministry. Please pray and consider going or giving toward the trip or to individuals raising funds to go.

Missions Conference: The Mission Team has begun planning the Fall Conference October 11-18, 2026. The theme is "Called To Go". Most of the meetings and activities will take place Sunday, Oct. 11 during regular service times and the weekend of Fri. Oct. 16 – Sunday, Oct. 18. Friday evening, we will meet for fellowship in host homes for Munchies with the Missionaries. On Saturday evening there will be dinner and stations where field workers will share their ministries. On Sunday we will hear presentations during each service and have a dessert fellowship in the evening. Some of the Field Workers attending are Pastor Mark and Val Appell, Paul and Tati Obradovic (WOL), Abbey Ballard with Life Saver Ministry, Taylor and Bri Kingfisher, Native American Ministries, and some other guests. Stay tuned for more information as the time gets closer. Pray for the team as we make plans and work out the details. If you are interested in hosting one of our field workers for dinner or want to help with one of the fellowship times, please let Chris Mayer or one of the team members know.
