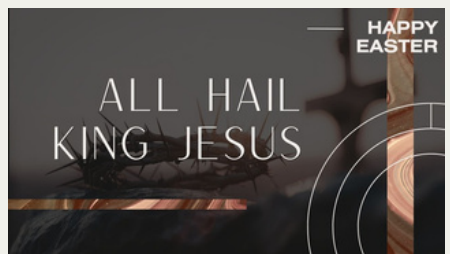
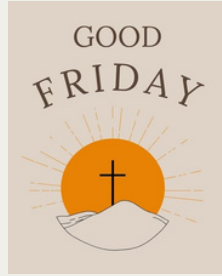
We had 15 teams competing, bringing together people from all across our community for a great time of fellowship, fun, and competition. Congratulations to the winning team "Got Milk"!

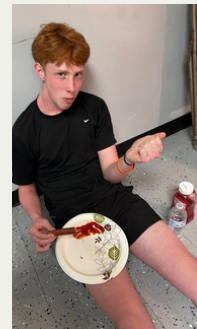
EASTER WEEKEND

As we approach the final weeks of June, we look back on this past fiscal year with profound gratitude. While changing our fiscal calendar timeline brought a season of transition, God has been remarkably faithful in guiding our leadership and blessing this new chapter. Through your constant prayers, tithes, and joyful offerings, our ministries have flourished, physical grounds have been maintained, and our commitment to missions has remained steadfast. This snapshot serves as a beautiful testimony to God’s provision and your collective obedience.

Financial Overview: Closing Strong

We are thrilled to report that we are positioned to close this fiscal year exceptionally strong, currently standing at \$9,254.73 in the black. Our actual total income reached \$328,203.00, outperforming our initial projections by \$12,003.00 (103.8% of budget). This surplus demonstrates the incredible generosity of our church family.

This note of thanks came from a social worker who submitted a CarePortal request for a single father who suffered a stroke two years ago. Though he faces significant paralysis, his faith in God and love for his daughters are truly inspiring.

After a delay of more than 40 days due to unforeseen circumstances, God brought everything together at just the right time. Within one week, Broadalbin Baptist Church joined as a new ministry partner, providing bed frames and mattresses, while Perth Bible Church supplied the bedding. Volunteers from both churches worked together to deliver and assemble the beds and pray with the family.

This story is a beautiful reminder that when God is at the center of our CarePortal ministry, He can do more than we could ever accomplish on our own. CarePortal is about more than meeting physical needs—it is about partnering with social workers, serving families in difficult circumstances, and sharing the hope of Christ through encouragement, prayer, and practical support.

Jail Ministry/ Angel Tree

As a partnering church with Prison Fellowship, our ministry through Angel Tree continues to impact families throughout the year. This past December, we had the privilege of providing gifts, prayer, and encouragement to 28 children and their families. We pray that the seeds planted will continue to grow as we build relationships, offer support, and invite these families to church services and events in the months ahead.

Hebrews 13:1-3 reminds us to love one another, show hospitality, and remember those in prison. Guided by this calling, Perth Bible's Jail Ministry is approaching its first anniversary with a team of 20 dedicated volunteers committed to bringing the hope, healing, and transforming power of Jesus Christ to inmates each week.

God has been at work in remarkable ways. We have witnessed lives changed, people surrendering their lives to Christ, heartfelt requests for prayer, and individuals finding hope in the midst of difficult circumstances. One recent highlight was distributing 110 Gospel bags at Easter, each containing the Book of John, an Easter booklet, and a salvation card. With the support of jail officials, every bag was distributed, and in the weeks that followed, God brought new inmates to hear the Gospel message. As this ministry continues to grow, we ask for your prayers.

We have seen hopelessness replaced with hope, lives transformed by Christ, and many leave the jail with a renewed purpose. While there have been difficult moments—including the passing of a woman who gave her life to Christ shortly before her release—we rejoice knowing that

God used this ministry to impact her life for eternity. God continues to open doors, change hearts, and remind us that no one is beyond the reach of His grace. God is good!

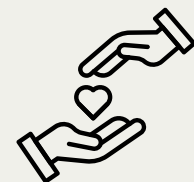

Key Accomplishments:

- Installed windows in interior doors to meet school compliance requirements and completed various door repairs throughout the facility.

The current Mission Team members are Chris Mayer (Secretary/coordinator), Jay and Denise Fiet, Linda Singer, Jean Pyzik and Darby Jensen.

We meet on the 1st Tuesday of each month, to discuss any missionary needs that arise, updates on missionaries, mission funds and distribution, and the annual fall conference. If you are interested in being on the mission team, let Chris or one of the other members know. You can even sit in on a meeting to check it out!

Mission Funds: As of May 1, 2026, we had \$4,768.00 in the Missions Faith Promise Account. We will transfer \$750 of that to the General Budget for Missionary Support. Simkah Bryant, daughter of Dan and Ginny serving in Senegal, W. Africa, is in the States attending Moody Bible Institute. This summer she will be going to a Discipleship Training School and serving in ministry and will need to raise support. We will be sending her a one-time gift of \$300.00 to help meet her goal. That will leave a balance of \$3050.00. We plan to use \$1700-\$2,000 towards upcoming mission trips as more funds come in.

Missionary Support: It has been recommended that the church take on Pastor Mark and Valerie Appell for missionary support of \$500/month beginning July first. This will be voted on in the annual meeting this month. We currently support 18 Field Workers and Ministries for a total of \$4,192.00 monthly, or \$50,304.00 yearly. (See the Monthly Support page)

Mission Trips: A trip to Ecuador to work with Jeff and Deanne Davoll is being planned for July 9-18, 2026. There will also be a trip to Brazil later this summer. Please consider going and/or giving toward either of these trips or to individuals who are raising funds to go.

Missions Conference: The Mission Team has begun planning for the Fall Conference October 11-18, 2026. The theme will be "Called To Go". Please pray with us that God would bring some guest ministry and field workers to join us at this year's conference. Pray for the team as we make plans and work out the details.

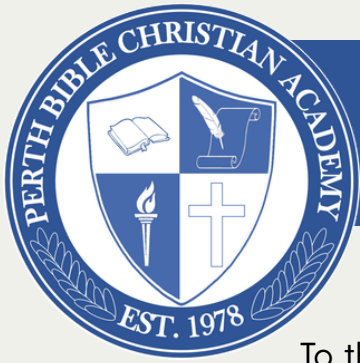
