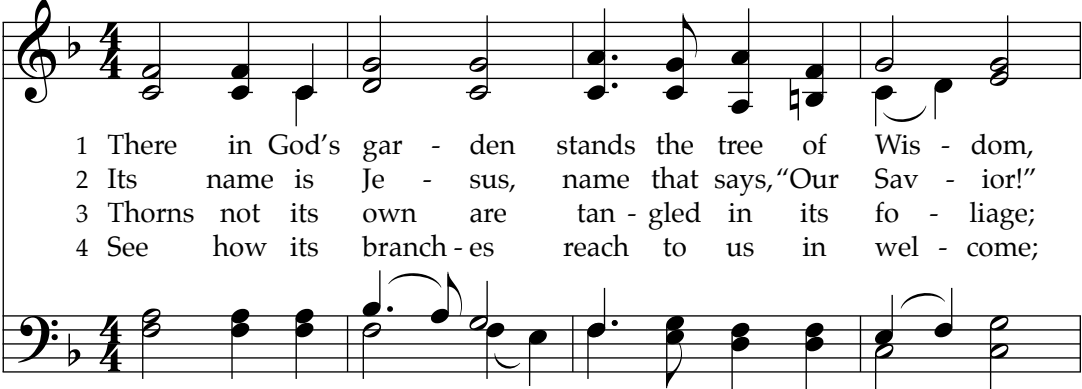
Before the world began, the Word was with God:

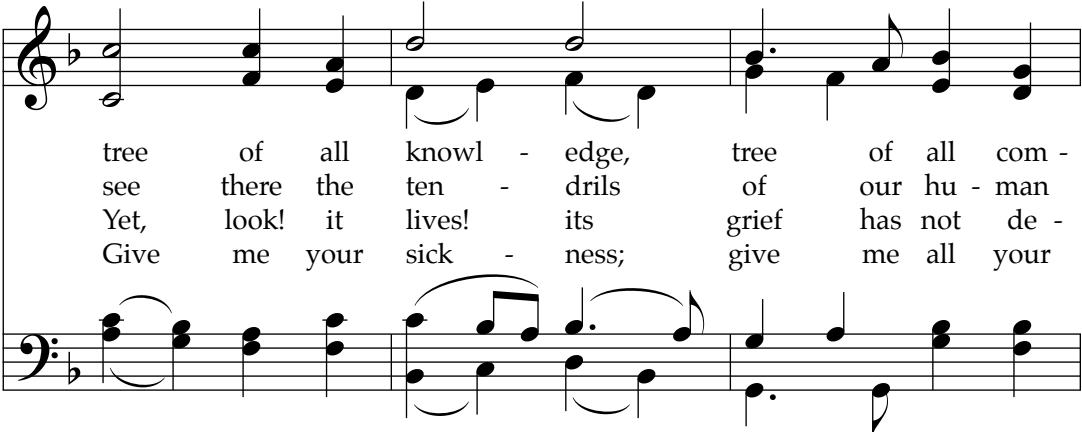

Friends, believe the good news:

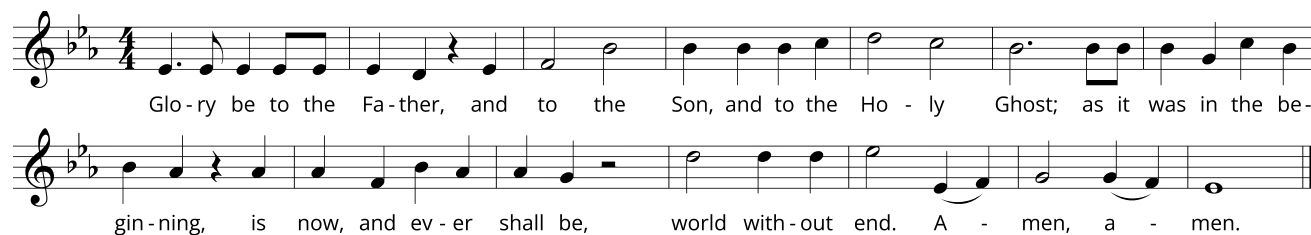
