## Serve The City

Wow, 2022 was an amazing year for our church regarding the impact your generosity made throughout the community!

- In January, we provided 700 individually wrapped desserts for Family Crisis Center's biggest fundraiser of the year. We provided over 50 'necessity bags' to the Family Crisis Center in February.
- In March and April we were able to support Project82 by providing a trailer loaded with diapers, Bibles, and \$1000 worth of Walmart gift cards.
- In May and June we were able to fill the Run5 Feed5 pantry with food items for summer deliveries.
- In August, we provided each staff member at Randleman Middle School with a \$25 gift card and many bins full of school supplies.
- In September, we held our first Serve the City Day and more than 100 volunteers served as the hands and feet of Jesus all over the community including Randleman Middle and High School, Victory Mountain Camp, Lydia's Place, Run5 Feed5, and Family Crisis Center and then fed the community both spiritually and physically with free lunch and free prayer.
- In October and November, over 450 church volunteers came together for the most successful Thanksgiving Meal Delivery experience yet. For the first time ever, every food box needed was provided beforehand and our goal of 100 teams was exceeded. We were able to provide a thanksgiving meal to 1730 people.

All of these things would not be possible without the time, energy, and provision of our church. Living and loving like Jesus is possible when we do it together.

## Men's Community Group

The Men's Community Group at Vintage Church exists to equip men to do four things:

Each one defines the purpose of what it means to be a Godly man. 2022 was a year of growth for the Men's Community Group at Vintage Church. One reason for the increase in the size of the group has been through word of mouth. Those who are attending are inviting others to join, and experience something different. Due to the increase in size, one goal of the group is to transition from Auditorium B to the main Auditorium.

The group remained focused on God's Word by studying the books of Nehemiah, Philippians, and also the Parables of Jesus. At each meeting, we incorporate both large group and small group discussion and study of God's Word. The focus is to be open and honest in our discussions so those involved are challenged to gain ground each day.

For 2023, we began with a study of the life of King Saul. Also, the Men's Community Group will get the opportunity to hold the first ever Men's Conference at Vintage Church. The event will be held on Saturday, April 29th. The focus of the conference will be leaving a lasting legacy, as men, for the next generation.

## [Czech] Missions

For the past few years Vintage has financially partnered with Global Partners to share the gospel in the Czech Republic. While the Czech Republic has a rich history of Christian faith, now there are estimated to be less than 1% of true Christ followers in this beautiful country. This year Vintage sent a team of 9 incredible leaders to assist with the annual English Camp outreach the Czech Republic. During the week of English Camp we assisted in sharing the gospel through individual conversations, camp gatherings, and our live-time examples as teams of campers competed in a variety of physical and mental challenges. These connections are being continued by the Global Partners workers living in Czech.

For multiple reasons, including 44 years under communist rule, most Czech people do not acknowledge their spiritual needs. Czech people are largely apathetic to the good news of Jesus Christ, but the campers showed interest in the messages shared during camp meetings. Aside from numerous personal “God moments” between Vintage leaders and Czech campers, let’s celebrate these stories:

- 46 native and immigrant Czech adults attended English Camp.
- 17 campers showed up to a Q&A with a Mexican pastor, Alejandro, who also assisted with camp.
- 12 campers attended a voluntary Discovery Bible Study, after meeting with Pastor Alejandro.
- 3 people noted on the end-of-camp survey that they would be interested in joining a Discovery Bible Study group.
- 2 individuals accepted Jesus as their Savior In the days following camp - a miraculous response!

We are honored that God used our team to help draw the Czech campers to Himself in 2022. Sharing the gospel in Czech Republic has been described as tilling hard, rocky soil (Luke 8:11-15); yet, workers are still needed for this harvest (Matthew 9:36-38). Vintage is looking forward to sending another team of fun-loving adventurers to assist with Czech Camp in 2023 inspiring more people to live and love like Jesus.
