

Deep Discipleship Program at CrossPointe Church

Fall 2026 – Spring 2027

Course Objectives: We believe that discipleship is best done in the context of the local church. With that, our desire is for the church to learn how to think biblically and theologically about everything. This is a comprehensive discipleship program that takes participants through the story of Scripture from Genesis to Revelation, emphasizing foundational Christian doctrines along the way while rooting participants in community and formative spiritual rhythms. This culminates in a greater love and knowledge of God, not just information but transformation.

Who should take this course: Someone who is looking for greater Bible literacy, a desire to grow deeper in their faith, and who has a strong drive to study and learn! This two-semester study has a goal of equipping believers with a curriculum that balances Christian Story through Bible literacy, Christian Belief through theological literacy, and Christian Formation through spiritual disciplines.

What is required: Attend and participate in the weekly 2 hour meeting, read assigned Bible passages, additional assigned readings, and complete practical assignments.

Expectations of the course: Due to the workload of the course, we are asking participants to not have more than one planned absence a semester to make sure the goals of this course are met. Participants are also expected to attend Sunday morning services at CrossPointe as this study does not replace the local gathering of believers.

Cost and Course Material: Participants will need a copy of the Deep Discipleship Journal. This workbook is available on Amazon or through Lifeway.com and costs about \$30. It includes all instructions, group questions, along with digital access to the three required books for the study. For those who want the three books in hard copy, those can be procured through the same websites. These books are: *You Are a*

Theologian by J.T. English & Jen Wilkin, *Remember and Rehearse* by J.T. English, *Formed for Fellowship* by Kyle Worley.

FAQs

How much time will the homework take me each week? The pre work each week includes 6-10 chapters of the Bible and an additional 1-2 chapters from the provided digital books. You should plan to set aside two hours to complete all pre work, this may take more or less time depending on your reading pace.

How much does the course cost? \$30-\$90 depending on if you want hard copies of all material or not.

When and where does the course meet? At CrossPointe from 4:00-6:00pm on Sundays. Childcare is provided.

When does it start and finish? The first class will be on Sunday, September 13th and finish May 9, 2027. See below for a detailed schedule.

What happens at the class each week? Group breakout sessions will discuss the pre work, along with teaching sessions and discussion over that teaching.

What happens after I take this course? Aside from helping people know and love God and others well, the aim of Deep Discipleship is to produce disciples who make disciples. As participants complete the program, they become better equipped to be commissioned into the life of the church as leaders. While some will return to their previous way of serving in the church, we hope many will feel called as leaders and disciple-makers.
