Luke 10:40 – Martha was distracted by the noise.

The Transfiguration – Luke 9:28-35

- Luke 9:33 – Peter was distracted by the noise
- Luke 9:34-35 – Listen to Him
  - Verse 35: A voice came from the cloud, saying, “This is my Son, whom I have chosen; listen to him.”

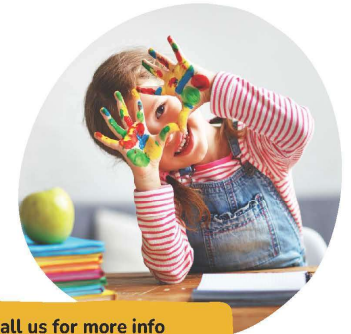
