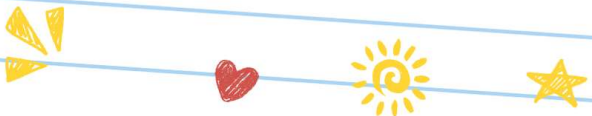

Love Like Jesus

Week #2 – Washes Feet

July 19, 2026

John 13:1-5

There are 3 very important things Jesus did to love others.

- Week #1 – Forgiveness
  - In order to be forgiven, we must forgive.
  - It improves our relationship with God (it strengthens our faith)
  - It improves our relationship with others
    - Forgiveness says, “I no longer feel the need to hold on to your involvement in my pain.” – Timothy Merrill
- Week #2 – Washes Feet
  - Jesus’ terrible, horrible, no good, very bad week:
    - Palm Sunday – parade! But he also had to defend his ministry.
    - Monday – he gets angry and turns over tables.
    - Tuesday – The tension with the religious leaders intensifies.
    - Wednesday – he didn’t go to the beach!
    - Thursday – dinner with friends. But those friends were arguing.
  - Jesus’ friends were too wrapped up in themselves to serve each other!
  - But Jesus washed their feet.
    - Why is this story here?
    - The plot doesn’t change.
    - It’s to teach us to love like Jesus.
  - How can you wash other people’s feet?
    - In your marriage/family?
    - At work?
    - At church?
    - What small things can you do to make people’s lives better?
