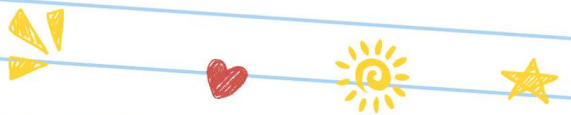

Sermon Notes

Love Like Jesus
Week #3 – Breaks Bread
July 26, 2026
Acts 2:42-47

There are 3 very important things Jesus did to love others.

- Week #1 – Forgiveness
 - In order to be forgiven, we must forgive.
 - It improves our relationship with God (it strengthens our faith)
 - It improves our relationship with others
 - Forgiveness says, “I no longer feel the need to hold on to your involvement in my pain.” – Timothy Merrill
- Week #2 – Washes Feet
 - Jesus’ terrible, horrible, no good, very bad week, but Jesus washed their feet.
 - Washing feet is the same as finding spontaneous ways to serve others in small ways.
 - How can you wash other people’s feet?
- Week #3 – Breaks Bread
 - We all know **why** Jesus came
 - To save our sins.
 - To serve rather than be served.
 - To preach good news to the poor.
 - To share the wisdom of the Kingdom of Heaven with us.
 - Do we know **how** Jesus came?
 - Not how he was born, how he interacted with the world.
 - Luke 7:34 – He came “eating and drinking.”
 - And the religious leaders hated him for it.
 - In Jesus’ day, mealtime was community time.
 - It’s not just about food.
 - It’s about building community.
 - The Book of Revelation is a series of festivals.
