Jonah #2 – The Fish Prayer

Pastor Kurt Tomlinson

August 30, 2026

Jonah 2:1-10

- Week #1 – Jonah in Us – Jonah 1:1-3
 - Jonah – the Reluctant Prophet
 - Jonah runs away. He doesn't negotiate with God; he just runs away.
 - When we run away, it's harmful.
- Week #2 – The Fish Prayer – Jonah 2:1-10
 - In the belly of a whale? No, a Great Fish.
 - Jonah learned what God was capable of.
 - Being in the fish clarified Jonah's call.
 - Lesson #1 – The Creator of the Universe hears our cries – and responds
 - 107 Billion, and counting
 - Distress = Tsarah
 - Deep in the realm of the dead = Sheol
 - Not Pinocchio, more like Men in Black
 - Lesson #2 – Sometimes it takes distress to get us to call out to God.
 - Hebrews 4:15-16.
 - We should approach the throne of grace with boldness.
 - Lesson #3 – Sometimes it takes distress (Tसार and Sheol) to be able to hear FROM God:
 - Jonah 2:9 – Deliverance comes from the Lord.
 - Deliverance comes – that means it's possible, we still have to do the work.

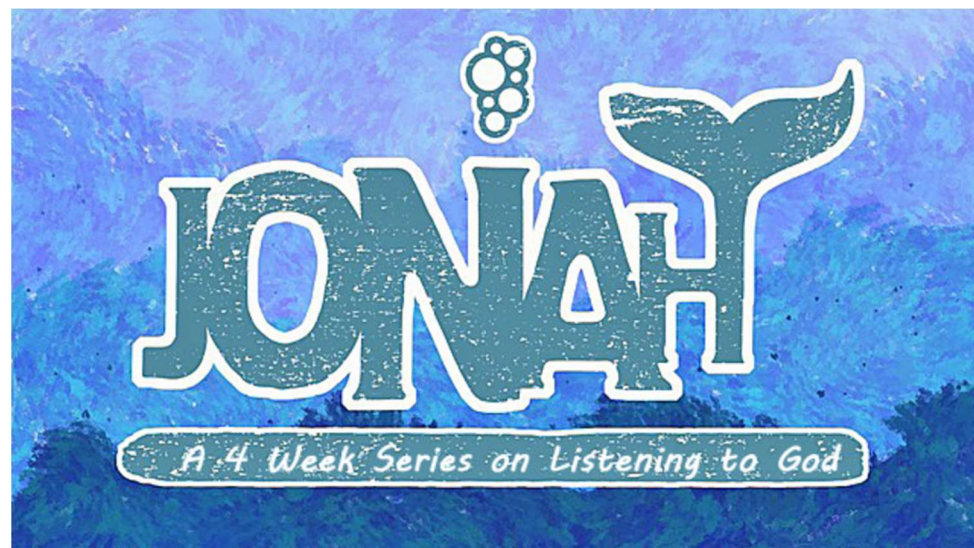
