Jonah #4 – Take Yes for An Answer

September 13, 2026

Jonah 4:1-10

Week #1 – Jonah the reluctant prophet – Jonah 1:1-3

- Jonah runs away. He doesn't negotiate with God; he just runs away.
- When we run away, it's harmful.

Week #2 – The Fish Prayer – Jonah 2:1-10

- Lesson #1 – The Creator of the Universe hears our cries – and responds
- Lesson #2 – Sometimes it takes distress to get us to call out to God.
- Lesson #3 – Sometimes it takes distress (to be able to hear FROM God.

Week #3 – Jonah Obeys (Sort of) – Jonah 3:1-10

- Our response to God's call is NOT a Formula – Matthew 12:38-41
- Our response to God's call can transform Society – Jonah 3:5

Week #4 – Take Yes for An Answer

- Jonah and the Plant and the worm
 - We don't have time to unpack this whole thing!
 - Jonah is having a temper tantrum – says 3 times he wants to die.
- Jonah was angry
 - To Jonah, it was an evil great and it burned like fire within his nostrils.
 - God, you are too forgiving!
- Luke 9:55
 - James and John were angry. They wanted the village destroyed.
 - Jesus rebuked them.

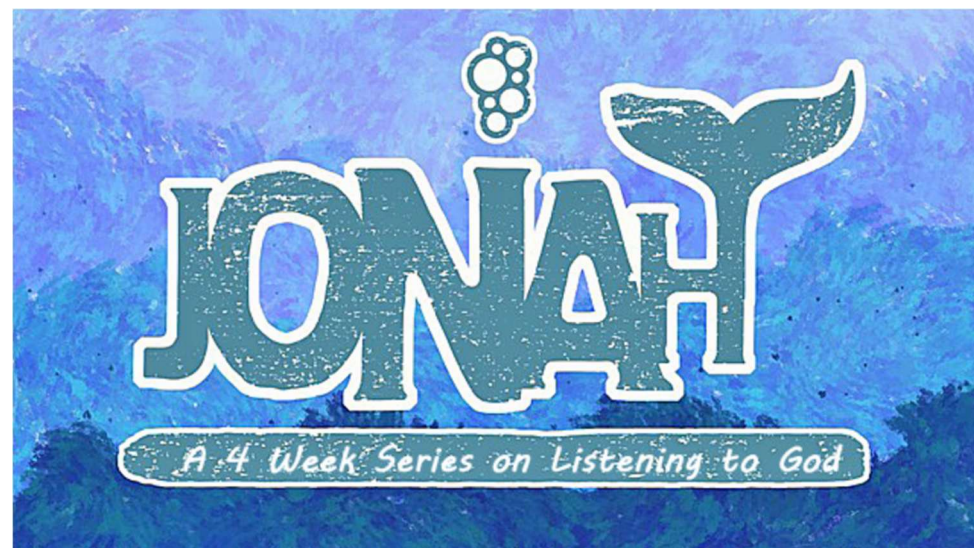
