THE PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Revelation 3:15-18

Our Father in Heaven, you know our deeds, that often we are neither cold nor hot. Those who are lukewarm — neither hot nor cold — you spit out of your mouth. We say, “We are rich; we have acquired wealth and do not need a thing.” But we do not realize that we are wretched, pitiful, poor, blind and naked.
