The Pastors' Page

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." Genesis 1:1

The English translation of the verse above uses the past tense of the verb "to create," making it seem like creation was a past action of God. However, while God isn't starting from scratch and remaking the Earth out of nothing every day, creation is not a past event. Rather, God continuously creates throughout human history, renewing and restoring creation rather than destroying it and starting anew. While creation might seem like a past event, it is a continuous action by God that renews and restores all creatures. Genesis 1 through 2 gives a wide shot of creation and the beginning of the World. When reading Genesis 1-2 through a scientific or mechanical lens, it is easy to see creation as a past event. After all, God "created" the world (emphasis on the past tense), and then "by the seventh day God had finished the work he had been doing" (Gen 1:1; 2:2). From this viewpoint, creation was the actions that God did to create the universe, the heavens, the Earth, and all creatures. However, Genesis 1-2 is more of a spiritual and philosophical account of creation rather than a scientific account. One of the purposes of Genesis 1-2 is to show that God created the world out of nothing. Additionally, it shows that God did not need to create Earth and humans. In the act of creation described in Genesis 1-2, God did not have to fight any other powers to create the universe. Instead, God created creatures simply because God wanted them to exist. God created creatures purely out of love. All of creation is connected in a circle, reflecting the love that God created out of. Creation, then, is defined as God's acts of creation out of nothing and out of love.

Given this definition, creation is an ongoing act and not simply the past events described in Genesis 1-2. The fact of our current existence is proof that creation is a continuous action, for our existence depends on God's will for us to exist. If our existence depends on God's desire for us to exist, this means that God must be constantly desiring for us to exist for us to exist from moment to moment. If God no longer wanted us to exist, then we would cease to exist. The force behind creation, God's will, must be constant and continuous for us to continue to exist, making creation constant and continuous. If God created everything from God's pure will and love, and nothing else, then no human, animal, or plant is a mistake or an afterthought. Rather, every human is an intentional act of creation by God. How differently would humans treat themselves if they saw themselves as products of love? If they believed their existence was based purely on God's desire for them to exist? In turn, how would human beings treat others if they saw others as creatures made from love? Furthermore, if humans believed creation was an ongoing act, would we be more open to change and growth? The tree does not argue and say that it is done maturing when it is a sapling. Neither does an eagle complain when it must learn to fly. And yet, human beings have a stubborn resistance to positive growth and maturation that often leads to harmful behaviors such as greed, insecurity, narcissism, and hatred for others. As humans, we have been created, but we are also continuously being created and shaped. As Christians, this shaping molds us further into reflections of Christ. Let us consider how God is constantly creating us and sustaining us in love, and let us grow into the image of our Creator, who loves all his creations equally.

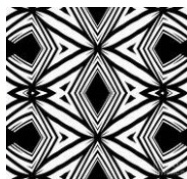
"Colorful July"

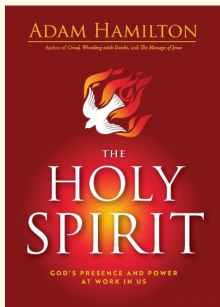


Summer Bible Study!

This year our Summer Bible study is a five-week study on the Holy Spirit, the often-overlooked person of the Trinity (Father, Son, Holy Spirit). This study will meet from 4:00-5:00 pm every Monday in August: August 3, 10, 17, 24, 31.

We will meet in Room 227 (Asbury Room). All are welcome to participate. This study will be led by Rev. Charlotte Brendel.

For this Bible study, we will use Adam Hamilton's most recent book, ***"The Holy Spirit: God's Presence and Power at Work in Us."*** We will explore together how the Holy Spirit is at work in the world. The Holy Spirit is God's active presence and power at work in the world and in our lives. Through the Spirit, we are transformed, led, empowered, and guided in our faith journey. Jesus promised his followers that the Spirit would come alongside them as comforter and counselor, empowering them to transform the world.

This study explores what Scripture teaches about God's Spirit. We will study Scripture from the Hebrew Bible (Old Testament) through Jesus' promises in the Gospels, the powerful Pentecost experience in Acts, and the rich teachings found in the New Testament letters. Our time together will help participants understand and experience the Holy Spirit's presence and power in their daily walk with Christ. This Bible study is a powerful, practical invitation for us to pay attention to the Holy Spirit at work in and through us. 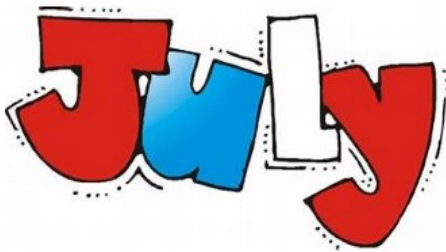

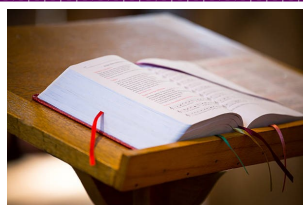
