CHRISTMAS BEGINS IN AUGUST?

We've heard of Christmas in July! It's that time of year when retailers remind us that Christmas is a mere six months away. Meanwhile, they offer great sales that will help us get ahead on our holiday shopping. While I enjoy the sales, I've never been able to wrap my head around Christmas shopping in July!

August is another story, however—and it's definitely something I can wrap my head and my heart around. That's often when many United Methodist Churches in the Western and North Carolina Conferences begin celebrating Christmas through our Project Agape mission effort (not to be confused with the Agape bags that are available for distribution within our own community). The Christmas shoeboxes we fill with age-appropriate items will go to children in Armenia. Life is tough for those served by Project Agape. Due to recent hostilities, many families were displaced, forced to leave their traditional lands. Imagine leaving homes and farms behind to re-start life in an unfamiliar place.

You may wonder, "Why do we start this mission effort so early?" It's a matter of timing. Those who adopt shoeboxes need time to gather the necessary items. When the shoeboxes are returned to the Church, a team requires time to process each one, ensuring that they contain all the items on the lists. Once that is completed, the shoeboxes are delivered to MERCI in Goldsboro before October 1.

Ordinarily, those who deliver the shoeboxes to MERCI spend the day going through stacks of *unchecked* boxes to ensure they are complete. No one wants a child to feel they have been short-changed! Saint Luke's *checked* boxes go straight from vehicle to large shipping containers. On their arrival in Armenia, they are distributed through the efforts of Nara Melkanyon, a dedicated servant who has spearheaded ministries there for a number of years. We celebrate the connection between the two conferences in North Carolina in this effort, and we are thankful for our connection with Christians in Armenia who have great needs. It's what the UMC is all about: being connected. We know we can accomplish more together than we can separately.

Filling Project Agape shoeboxes offers a great opportunity for us to involve the children in our lives. One year, I took my teenaged grandson shopping with me. While he was not engaged initially, he grew excited about choosing items for children he would never meet. During Vacation Bible School this summer, we provided several items for our VBS participants to pack in this year's shoeboxes. When those shoeboxes reappear on August 9th, please remind the children that they had a role in showering Christmas blessings on children who live 6,000 miles away.

When does Christmas in August begin? August 9th

Project Agape shoeboxes will be available in Perry Foyer, Williams Lobby and Casey Chapel Lobby. There will be 24 boxes for each age group (96 in total): 0-2, 3-6, 7-12 & 13-18, equally divided between male and female. Per Armenian law, all items must be new.

Last day to return shoeboxes? September 6th

If you would assist with the distribution of boxes or volunteer to check boxes, see Rev. Judy.

Meanwhile, let's pray—and prepare—for a blessed Christmas for Armenian children!

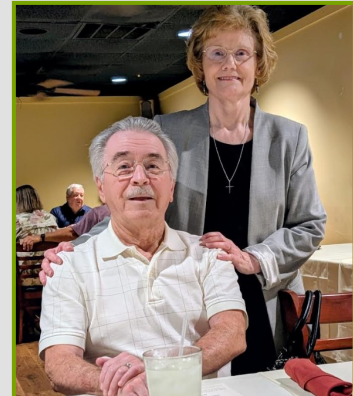

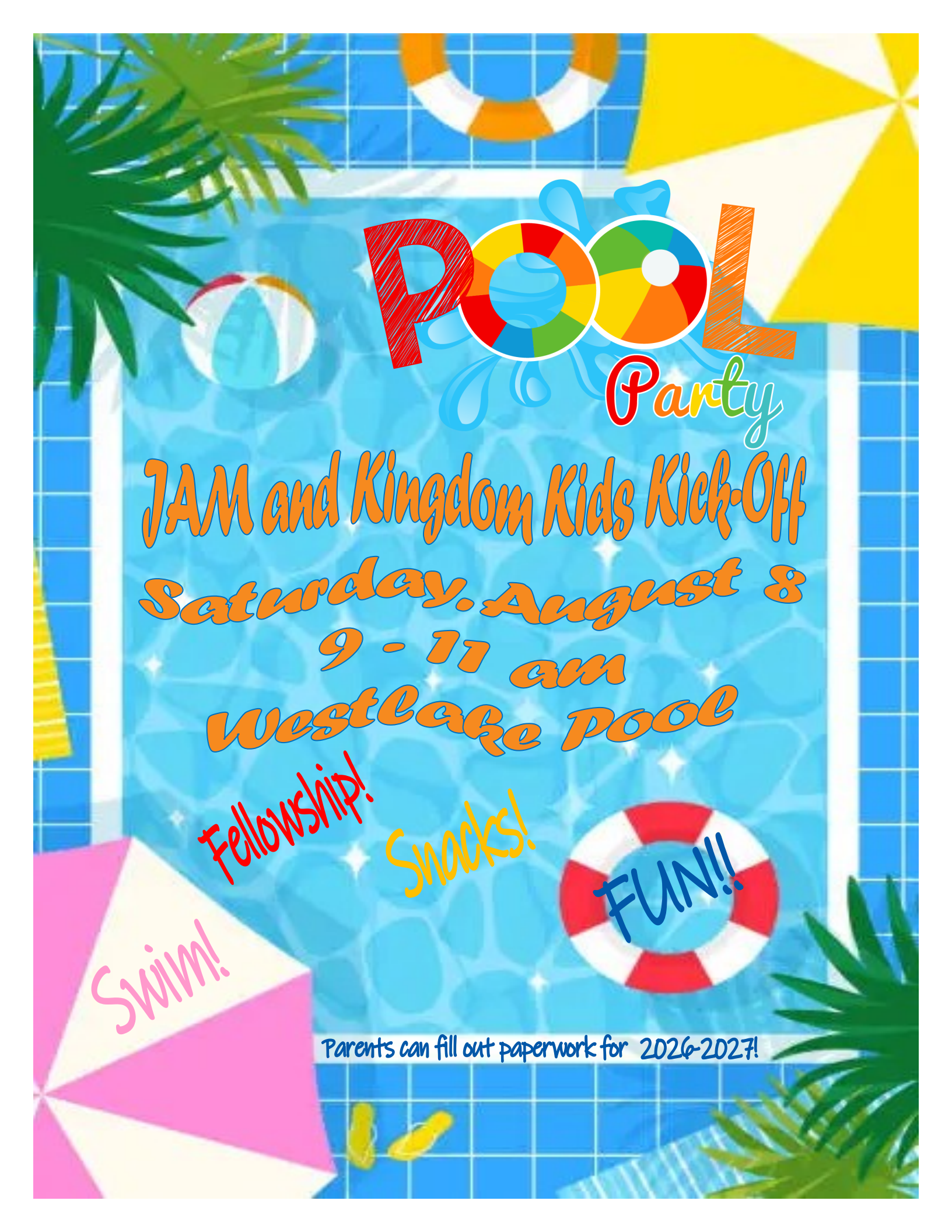

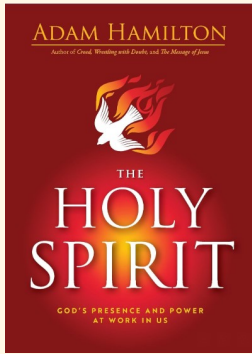

Summer Bible Study!

This year our Summer Bible study is a five-week study on the Holy Spirit, the often-overlooked person of the Trinity (Father, Son, Holy Spirit). This study will meet from 4:00-5:00 pm every Monday in August: August 3, 10, 17, 24, 31. We will meet in Room 227 (Asbury Room).

All are welcome to participate. This study will be led by Rev. Charlotte Brendel.

For this Bible study, we will use Adam Hamilton's most recent book, ***"The Holy Spirit: God's Presence and Power at Work in Us."*** We will explore together how the Holy Spirit is at work in the world. The Holy Spirit is God's active presence and power at work in the world and in our lives. Through the Spirit, we are transformed, led, empowered, and guided in our faith journey. Jesus promised his followers that the Spirit would come alongside them as comforter and counselor, empowering them to transform the world.

This study explores what Scripture teaches about God's Spirit. 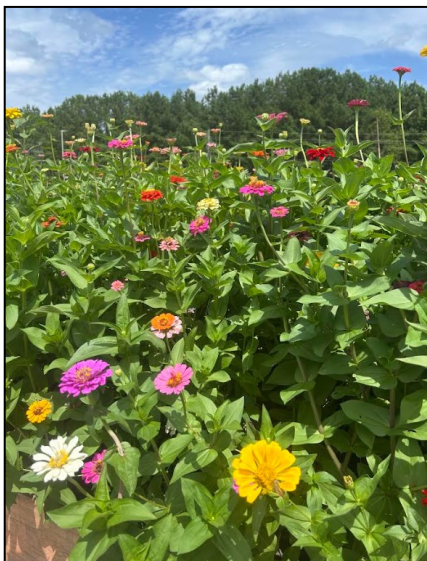

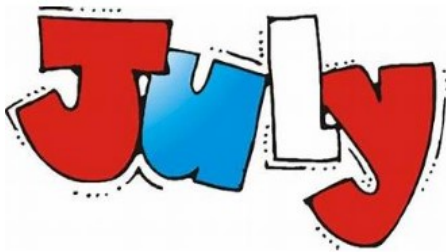
