The Pastors' Page

The Old Testament lesson for Sunday, June 14, tells a familiar story about Abraham's encounter with the Lord at the Oaks of Mamre. As the story goes, when Abraham looked up, he was surprised by three men who stood before him. As was customary in places where food and water were precious commodities, Abraham quickly offered them the hospitality and safety of his home (a tent) and his table.

After their meal, one of the strangers—now referred to as the Lord—reiterated a promise made to Abraham earlier when he was *99 years old*. That promise was that he and Sarah would have a son who would be called Isaac. Upon that first pronouncement, Abraham laughed! Concealed in the tent at the Oaks of Mamre, Sarah overheard the second pronouncement—and she laughed! She had no illusions about their ability to have a child at their advanced ages! Only the stranger—now understood to be the Lord—asked Sarah, *“Is anything too wonderful for the Lord?”* (Genesis 18:14)? As their promised son, Isaac, grew from infancy to manhood in the ensuing years, I imagine a joyful Abraham and Sarah laughed often and loudly.

“Is anything too wonderful for the Lord?” These words run through my mind at regular intervals today. I sense a message for me here—perhaps for you as well. Sarah had grown jaded by her unrequited desire to have her own child. Perhaps I (we) have despaired of certain situations changing or delayed hopes being realized. Like Sarah, perhaps we all need a reminder that nothing is too hard or too hopeless for God to restore, re-create, redeem, resolve or remove.

“Is anything too wonderful for the Lord?” I invite you to say the words out loud a few times, putting emphasis on different words. There is a certain energy to these words from Genesis. They offer an awakening, a rebirth of hope. They reflect endless possibility, a reclamation of dreams and expectations. They have power to quicken a faltering spirit.

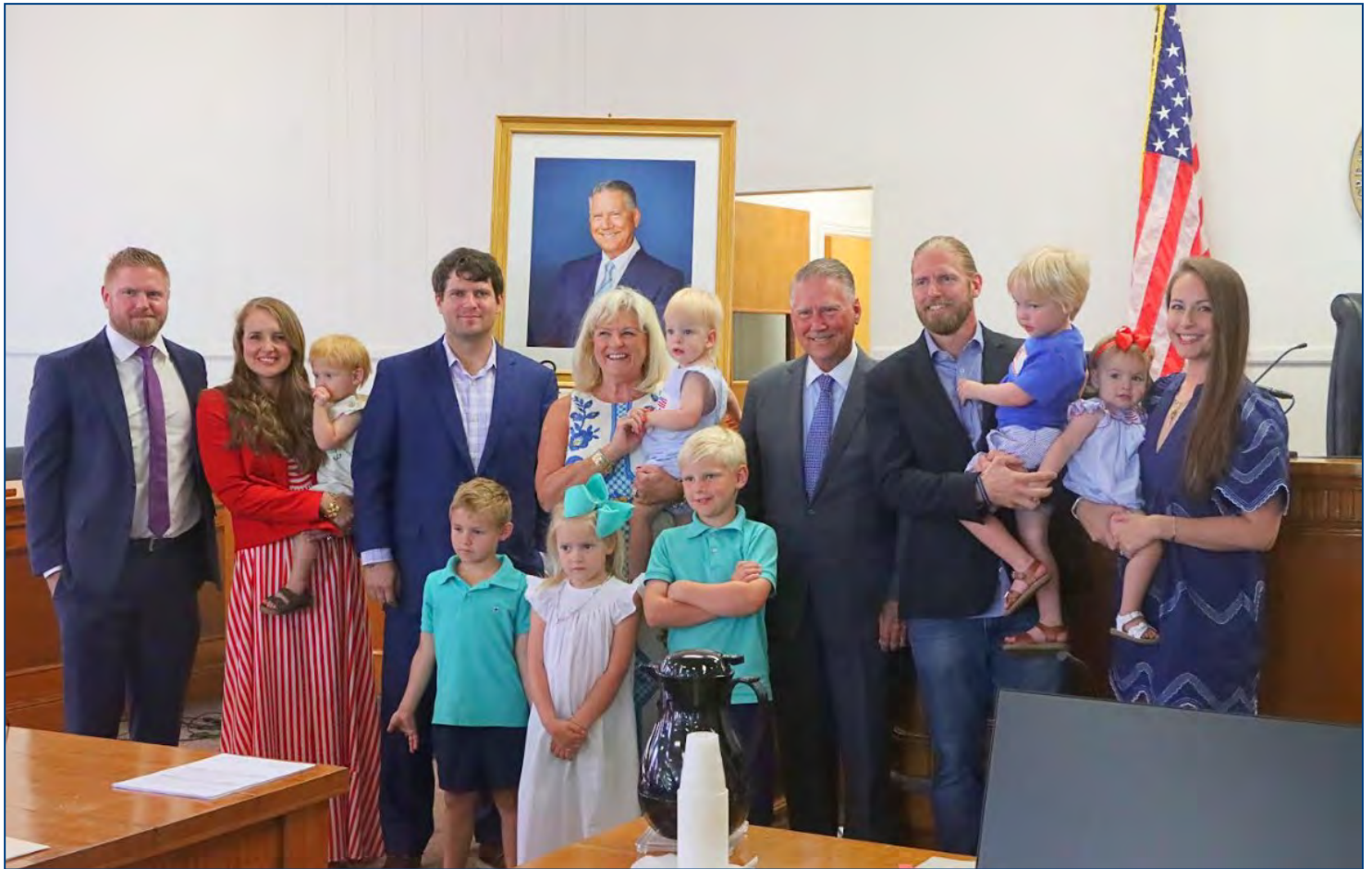
In a class at Wesley Theological Seminary in Washington, DC, we students were assigned a book by James Baldwin to read. Baldwin was an outstanding African-American author. As I read his written words, I sensed a rhythm to them. I felt it to my very core. Astounded by the physical and spiritual reaction that Baldwin's words evoked in me, I spoke to the professor about it. He informed me that Baldwin wrote that particular book in jazz rhythm. Can you imagine the creative genius that required? From my personal experience, I can attest to his effectiveness!

There is something akin to that experience in these words spoken to Sarah from Genesis 18:14—indeed, from all of Scripture. From Moses' confrontation with Pharaoh to David's heroic challenge to Goliath; from the Psalmists' praises of God's deliverance to a young woman's acceptance of the news that she would bear a son; from Jesus' own invitation to “follow me” to the Spirit's manifestation in the Upper Room; from Paul's conversion and ministry to the Gentiles to the spread of the Church throughout the known world; from the words proclaimed in our services of worship to the sanctuaries of our minds and spirits, the rhythm of God's word continues to invite, challenge, engage, empower, and inspire the People of God to tear down dividing walls and sing the song of salvation for the good of humankind and the world.

“Is anything too wonderful for the Lord?” I think not. I will be sitting with these words for a while. They are speaking...and ministering...to my soul.

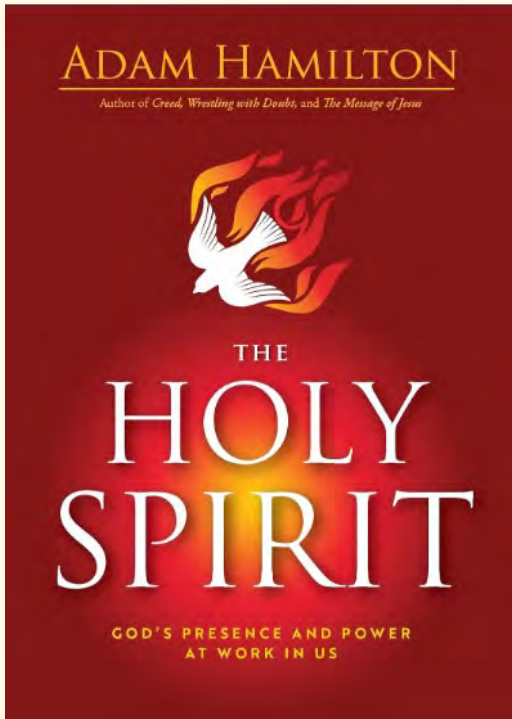

This year our Summer Bible study is a five-week study on the Holy Spirit, the often-overlooked person of the Trinity (Father, Son, Holy Spirit). This study will meet from 4:00-5:00 pm every Monday in August: August 3, 10, 17, 24, 31. We will meet in Room 227 (Asbury Room). All are welcome to participate. This study will be led by Rev. Charlotte Brendel.

For this Bible study, we will use Adam Hamilton's most recent book, *"The Holy Spirit: God's Presence and Power at Work in*

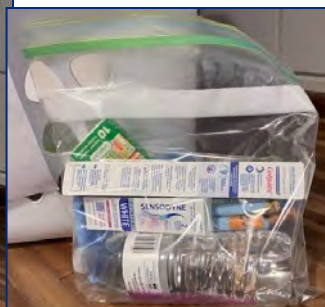

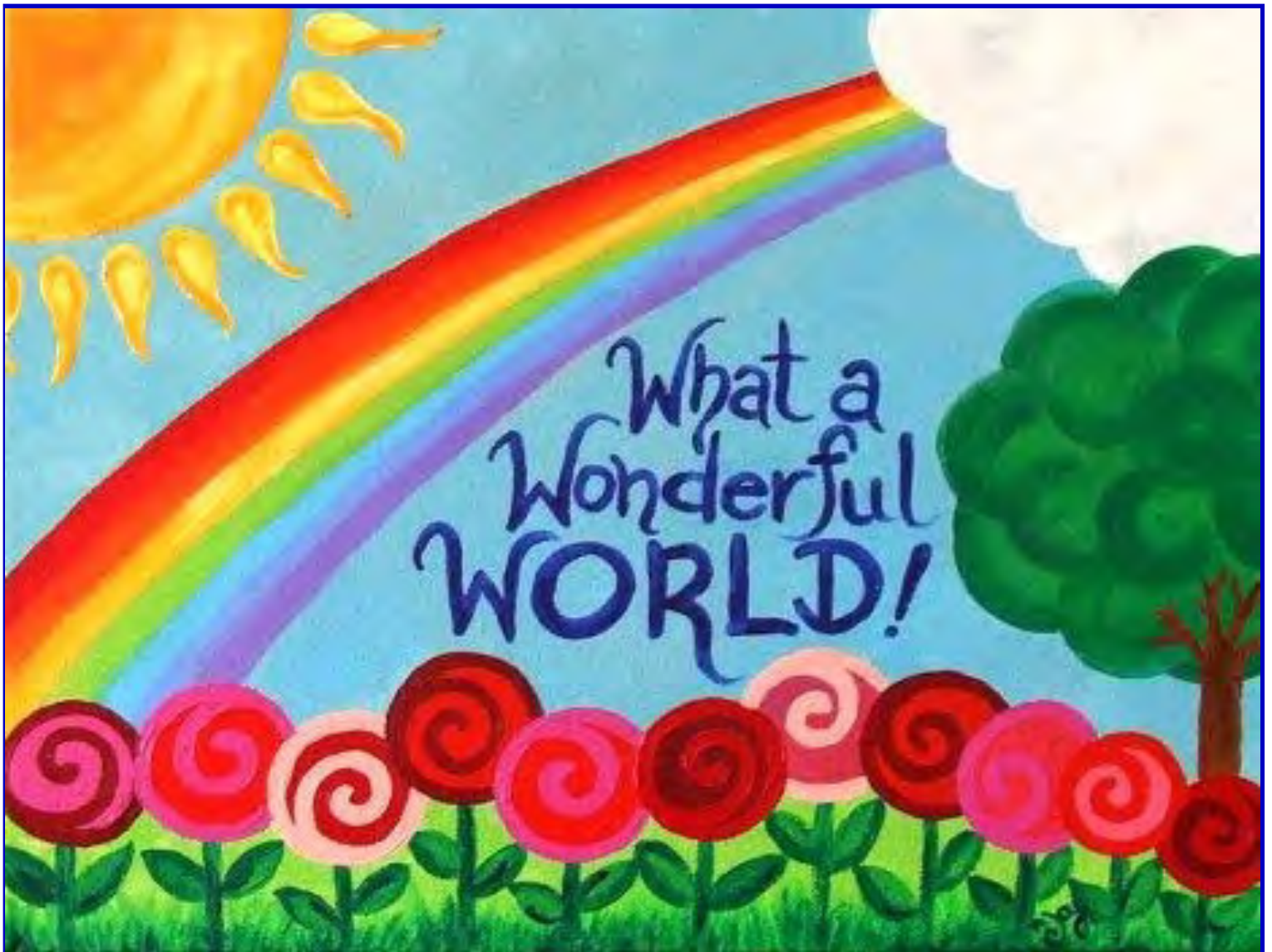

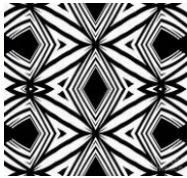
"Colorful July"

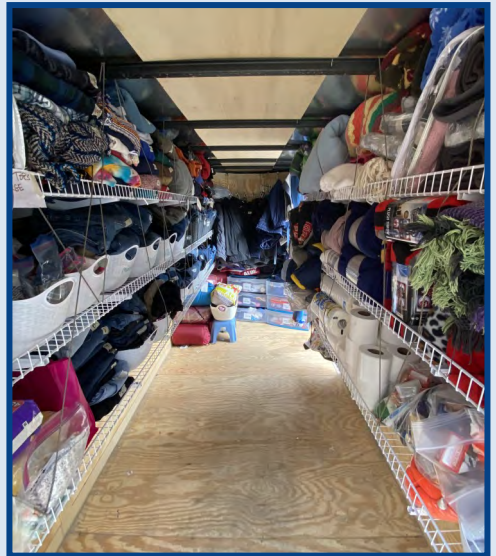
