The Pastors' Page

"The apostles gathered around Jesus and reported to him all they had done and taught. Then, because so many people were coming and going that they did not even have a chance to eat, he said to them, 'Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest.'" Mark 6:30-32

I often share with individuals the importance of maintaining a proper balance in our lives. Utilizing the image of a three-legged stool, I stress how each of the three main areas of our existence—our physical, emotional/mental, and spiritual—must be kept in proper alignment in order for our lives to be what God intended them to be. If we fail to give the proper attention to any one of the three, we will find our lives out of balance and not truly in sync in the way God created us. In the example of the three-legged stool, more emphasis is placed on each individual leg. A four-legged stool may be able to continue to stand even if one leg is out of proportion. But with only three legs, if one is not equal to the others, the chances are, soon things will quickly go toppling over.

During the months of July and August, our own Katherine Holt will be attending to one of the legs of her stool. For the past 11 years, Katherine has faithfully and diligently served our church Sunday after Sunday. Her first two years of service were served as our Nursery Coordinator, and the last nine have been as Director of Children's and Family Ministries. Because of her weekly obligations and commitment to her job, Katherine's opportunities to worship have been limited. There has been the occasional Sunday away or special service, but as it pertains to the spiritual nourishment experienced in weekly and regular corporate worship, because of her role at Saint Luke, she has missed out.

So, with the blessings of the Staff-Parish Relations Committee, and most definitely the encouragement of her pastor, Katherine will be entering a time of spiritual renewal. She has made sure that all of her areas of responsibility will be covered. She will be off of the grid in regards to fielding phone calls and dealing with any issues that might arise. She is, just as Jesus told his disciples to do, going away with Jesus to a quiet place to get some rest.

I am so proud of Katherine for recognizing her need for spiritual refreshment and nourishment. My prayer is that she will come back after her time away truly renewed from having experienced a wonderful awareness of God's presence with her. But this prayer would not be limited to Katherine. I want all of our Saint Luke folks to be the healthiest versions of themselves – physically, emotionally/mentally, and certainly spiritually. But along with our prayers for God's Spirit to be upon us, I believe that it also requires our willingness to commit ourselves to the task.

My friends, we've each been given an incredible gift in the lives with which God has blessed us. Let us determine that we will not only appreciate that gift, but that we will do our part to help maintain and safeguard every aspect of that which we are. One wonderful way to continue, or begin this process, is to commit ourselves to going with Jesus to that quiet place and finding the rest that God would give to us. Let us determine that we do indeed want to be the best that we can be, for the sakes of our own lives, as well as for the sake of God's Kingdom.

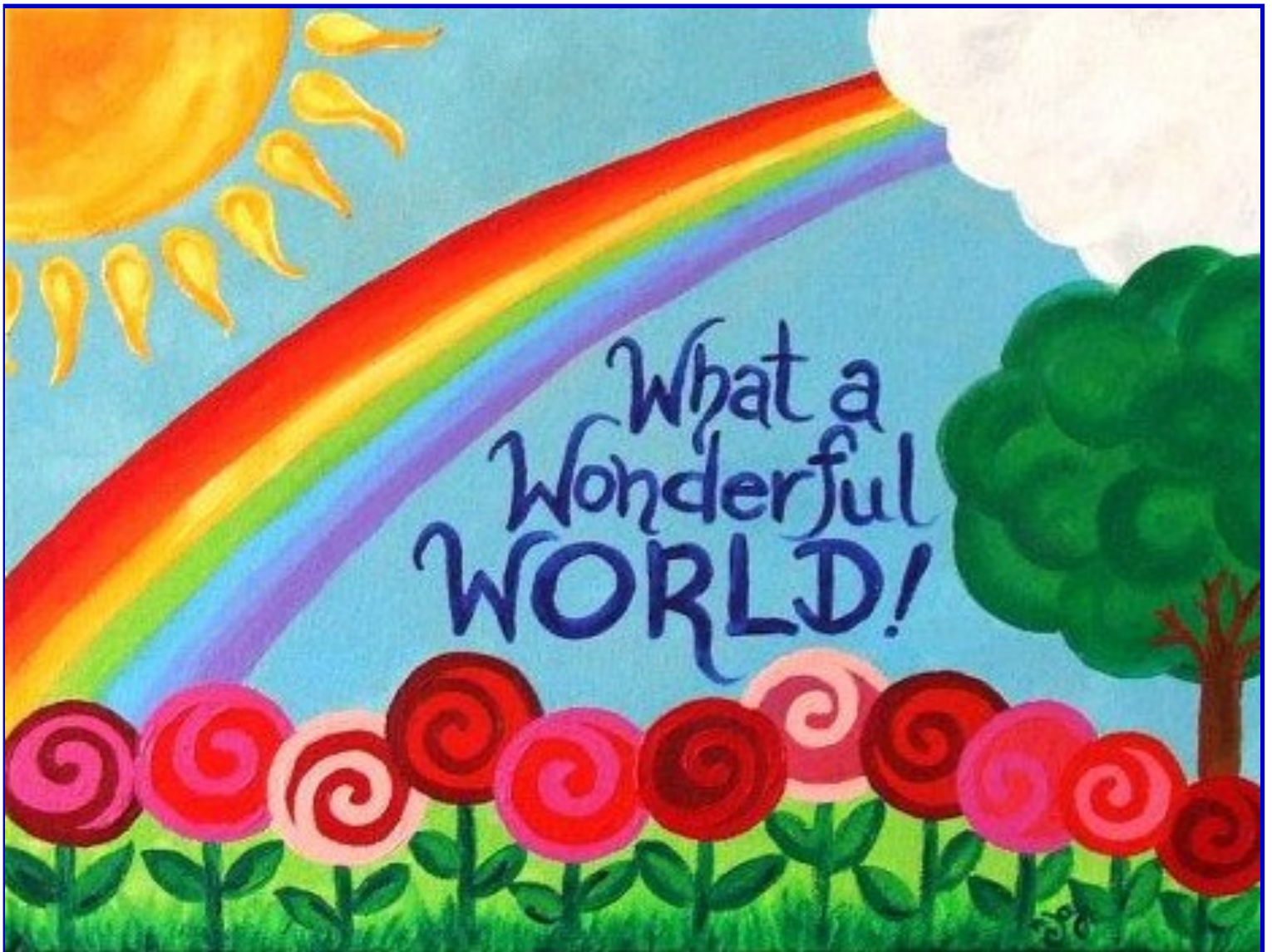


Just for July ...

Our Ladies Lunch & Learn will begin Year #3 in July! New theme for 2026-2027: *"Unto the Least of These."* Matthew 25:34b-40 is our Scriptural foundation.

'Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world, 35 for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, 36 I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me.'

*37 Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry and gave you food or thirsty and gave you something to drink? 38 And when was it that we saw you a stranger and welcomed you or naked and gave you clothing? 39 And when was it that we saw you sick or in prison and visited you?' 40 And the king will answer them, 'Truly I tell you, **just as you did it to one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did it to me.'***

Each month we will celebrate a different outreach ministry in our community. A guest speaker will join us to share about a special ministry, how people are helped, and the greater impact the ministry has in the Sanford area. This year is all about people helping people, as we learn more about how God is moving in our midst through ministries with the least among us. Join us for a unique year exploring outreach "unto the least of these."

Our Guest Speaker for Wednesday, July 15 is Laura Spivey, Executive Director of Outreach Mission Inc. Outreach Mission Inc. (OMI) operates as a fully integrated housing system that connects emergency services, housing access, financial empowerment, and long-term support. The result is a structured pathway that moves individuals from crisis to stability while promoting independence, reducing reliance on public systems, and strengthening the overall community. Their "Hands Up to Housing" Program empowers clients to gain knowledge and tools to achieve the goal of obtaining stable housing. Rather than placing clients in housing without the skills to move forward, OMI works with clients to help them budget, find stable employment and move forward. Executive Director Laura Spivey will share about several other programs available through Outreach Mission Inc.

We will gather at Davison's Restaurant in the back room at 11:30 am to eat lunch together (Dutch Treat), then enjoy a time of sharing and learning. Ladies Lunch & Learn is for women of all ages! 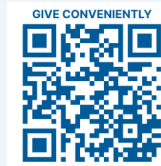

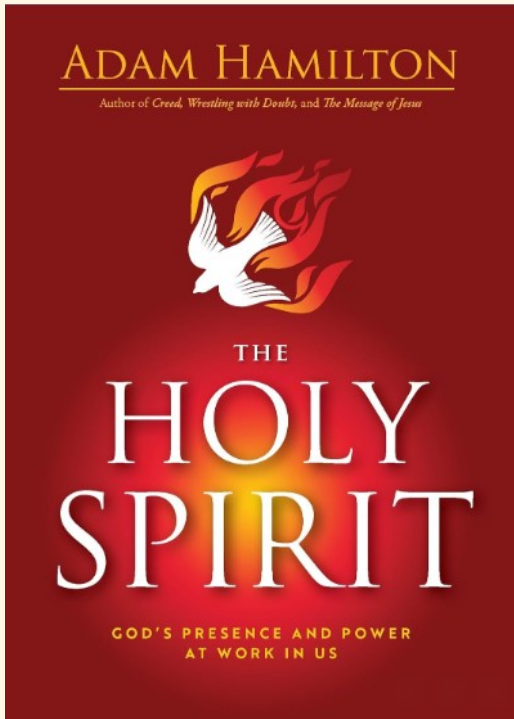

Summer Bible Study!

This year our Summer Bible study is a five-week study on the Holy Spirit, the often-overlooked person of the Trinity (Father, Son, Holy Spirit). This study will meet from 4:00-5:00 pm every Monday in August: August 3, 10, 17, 24, 31. We will meet in Room 227 (Asbury Room). All are welcome to participate. This study will be led by Rev. Charlotte Brendel.

For this Bible study, we will use Adam Hamilton's most recent book, *"The Holy Spirit: God's Presence and Power at Work in*

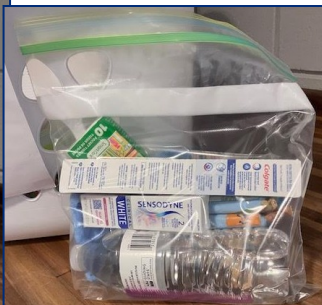
Us." We will explore together how the Holy Spirit is at work in the world. The Holy Spirit is God's active presence and power at work in the world and in our lives. Through the Spirit, we are transformed, led, empowered, and guided in our faith journey. 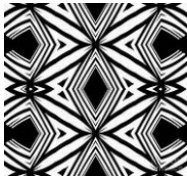
"Colorful July"

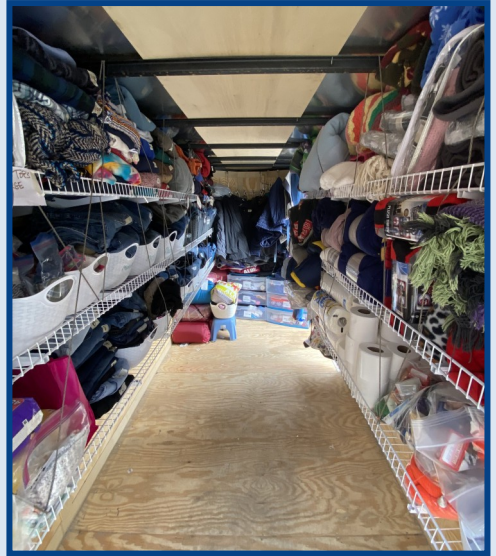

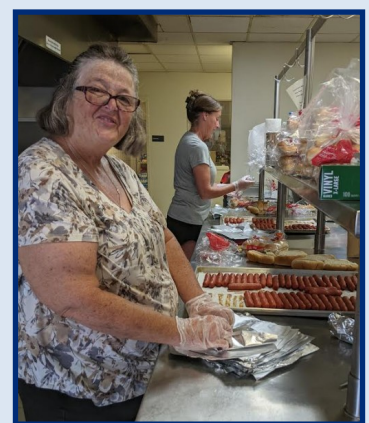

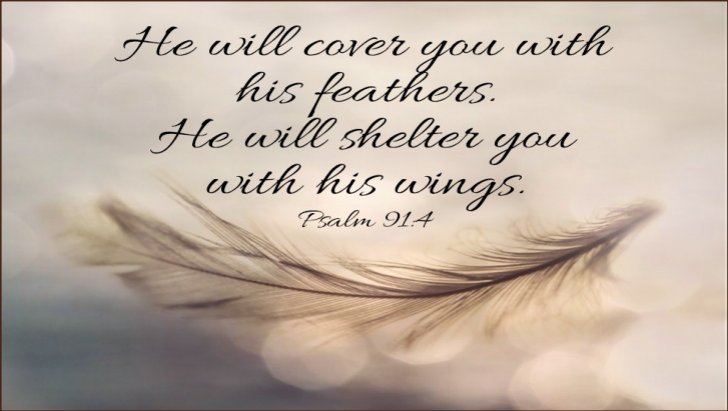
