Discuss

- How have you experienced unity among believers within FBC?
- How have you seen the body of Christ function according to I Corinthians 12?
- As a member of the body of Christ how can you demonstrate that you value the church as He does?
- How have you experienced care and love from the church or churches of which you've been a part? *See 12:25*.

Do

Consider how this all plays out in our lives and apply it to everyday life.

- Read I Corinthians 12:25
- Pray for one another Pray for another family at FBC. Sign up for the prayer request emails from FBC. Pray for FBC's missionaries. Pray for the ministries at FBC.
- Invite one another Practice hospitality and invite another family, couple, or single person to dinner. Invite others for a game night and fellowship time. Invite friends to have a date night while you care for their kids.
- Encourage one another Send notes of encouragement. Learn people's names. Speak words that build people up reminding them of God's love and goodness in their lives.
